#### **RESOLVED:**

- (a) That the process for the selection for redundancy was followed to a sufficient degree to arrive at a fair conclusion and therefore the Panel approve the selection of this post holder as the employee whose post will be made redundant if the Policy and Resources Committee approve the recommendations of the report on restructuring a section of the Community Services Directorate which they are considering at their meeting on 21 March 2001, in the light of the views expressed by the Advisory Cabinet at their meeting on 7 March 2001;
- (b) That the Panel strongly recommend to the Advisory Cabinet and the Policy and Resources Committee that the effective date of such redundancy should be extended until 31 October 2001 to ensure coverage during a busy period in the service concerned.
