## **DELEGATION OF POWERS TO OFFICERS**

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Council has an extensive scheme of powers delegated to the officers in order to conduct its business as smoothly and efficiently as possible.
- 1.2 On 18 November 2002 it was agreed to change the Senior Management Structure of the Council and all the powers delegated to the former Director of Environment Services were transferred to either the Director of Community Services or the Director of Resources (Cabinet minute 87, 18 November 2002; and Council minute 40, 18 November 2002 refer). The opportunity has however now been taken to look at the delegations more closely to make sure that they still reflect the most pragmatic way in which tasks need to be carried out. In addition, it is necessary to reflect other changes, such as the setting up of the Test Valley Partnership for the operation of Commercial Services, and revised Highway Agency arrangements.

#### 2. THE PROPOSED CHANGES

- 2.1 The proposed amendments to the Scheme of Delegations of Powers to Officers are attached as Appendix 1 to this report. Proposed deletions are in text that has been struck through (i.e. proposed deletions). Proposed additions are shown in bold type (i.e. proposed additions). In essence the proposed changes fall into the following main categories:
  - (i) The deletion of the powers delegated to the Director of Commercial Services when the Test Valley Partnership was first established (e.g. no's 11, 28, 51) and their replacement with a revised scheme which is more equivalent to the delegations which apply in other Directorates of this Council (new delegations following no 81)
  - (ii) The inclusion of additional officers into existing powers, usually to reflect amendments to the Management Structures within Directorates (e.g. no's 73-78), or to widen the range of people within a Directorate who can sign essential documents.
  - (iii) New delegations under new legislation or Regulations (e.g. new delegation following no. 103)
  - (iv) Delegations where the transfer of the powers exercised by the Director of Environment Services to another Director would not be the best course of action (e.g. no's 134 and 137)
  - (v) Tidying up and seeking greater consistency between delegations (e.g. deleting no's 289 and 290, and amending no 287)

- (vi) Deleting powers that are no longer required (e.g. no's 147 to 154)
- 2.2 Pages 1-34 inclusive of Appendix 1 are the responsibility of the Council and were agreed by them at their meeting on 28 April 2003. Pages 35-52 inclusive are for the Cabinet to consider.

### 3. CRIME AND DISORDER, ENVIRONMENTAL AND FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 None arising directly from this report.

#### 4. RECOMMENDATION

4.1 That the amendments to the Scheme of Delegation of Powers to Officers, that are the responsibility of the Cabinet, as set out in Appendix 1 to this report, be approved and adopted with immediate effect.
