In addition to those changes the terms "Solicitor" and "L Moore – Solicitor" need to be replaced by "Solicitor or Employed Barrister, throughout the Scheme of Delegation and Proper Officer Appointments. This is to reflect recent changes in the establishment of the Legal Services Section.
