## 94. GARDEN WASTE COLLECTION SCHEME (REPORT B).

The Cabinet considered the merits of introducing a Garden Waste Collection Scheme.

Members noted that an agreement had now been reached with Hampshire County Council in relation to the transfer station sites for the garden waste. The sites would be situated at Somerley and Blue Hayes, Ringwood. In view of this the Cabinet agreed that it would sensible to change the area for the pilot scheme to cover the areas of Ashurst, Barton, Bransgore, Fordingbridge, Lyndhurst, Milfordon-Sea and Ringwood for ease of collection and transfer.

#### **RECOMMENDED:**

That a supplementary estimate of £22,700 in 2004/05 be approved to enable the introduction of a Garden Waste Collection Scheme and the expenditure plans for 2005/06 onwards be amended accordingly.

#### **RESOLVED:**

That, subject to the Council's approval of the supplementary estimate as set out above, the implementation of the Garden Waste Collection Scheme, as set out in Report B to the Cabinet be approved, with effect from 14 March 2005, subject to the pilot area being changed to cover Ashurst, Barton, Bransgore, Fordingbridge, Lyndhurst, Milford-on-Sea and Ringwood.
