

SCHEME OF DELEGATION OF POWERS TO OFFICERS

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The scheme of delegation of powers to officers needs to be amended slightly to authorise additional officers to appear in the Magistrate's Court, on this Council's behalf, on cases relating to recovery and enforcement of the council tax, non-domestic rates and related issues.
- 1.2 Historically, the officers appointed to carry out these duties have been authorised to attend court, by name. It would however be opportune to make the delegations apply to posts, rather than individuals, to avoid reports being submitted to Cabinet each time there is a change in personnel.
