EXPENDITURE PLAN CONSULTATION

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The process and the timetable for the Expenditure Plans for 2007/08 was included in the Financial Strategy approved by the Council in July 2006. The timetable included consultation with all Review Panels and Committees during November, and for any recommendations or comments arising from those meetings to be reported back to Cabinet in December.
- 1.2 This report includes the comments that the Members of the Review Panels and Committees wish to make to Cabinet.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS / COMMENTS FROM PANELS AND COMMITTEES

2.1 Corporate Overview

2.1.1 The Panel had no comments on the proposals in the report but recommended that all Members of the Council receive a grant allocation under the Rural Assistance Grant scheme. They preferred retaining a sum of £500, but recognised that Cabinet may wish to amend this sum depending on budgetary considerations. They also recommended that the scheme should be renamed the District Councillors' Community Grants scheme to reflect its wider availability.

2.2 Crime and Disorder

2.2.1 Members resolved that Cabinet be advised that Panel have no comments to make on the proposed capital and revenue expenditure items, apart from re-emphasising the need for every effort to be made to secure financial contributions from partner organisations and beneficiaries of the Council's CCTV system, so that it does not represent an unfair burden on the communities that are not covered.

2.3 Economy and Planning

2.3.1 After consideration, the Panel concluded that it had no budget changes to recommend, as there was very little room for manoeuvre, given that much of the Portfolio budget spend was imposed. Lead Scrutiny Members for each service undertook to re-examine the budget position closely to confirm that no further savings could be identified.

2.4 Environment

It was resolved that Cabinet be advised that:

- 2.4.1 Revenue expenditure bid items 1-7 and 9-12 inclusive were unavoidable if the Council was to meet its statutory requirements or existing commitments, including the imperative to improve recycling performance. It was noted, however, that item 8, a sum of £10,000 for a feasibility study to identify alternative burial sites, could initially be delayed from 2007/08 to 2008/09 on the understanding that the bid could be brought forward again should the Council's financial position improve. The Panel was pleased to commend the savings and additional income identified in items 13-18:
- 2.4.2 Panel recommend Cabinet to increase the number of clear recycling sacks provided from 52 per annum to 72 per annum, in order to increase recycling performance, but that the facility to obtain further additional free clear sacks be removed. This would result in a net additional revenue expenditure bid of £53,000;
- 2.4.3 Panel recommended that an additional revenue expenditure bid of £15,000 be included to enable the number of cuts on highways verges to be increased from 10 per annum to 11 per annum;
- 2.4.4 Panel noted that all the capital expenditure items relating to coastal defence would be funded by Government Grant and other external contributions. The Panel debated whether there was potential to reduce the budget allocation for the replacement and refurbishment of public conveniences and concluded that, in the light of capacity problems at some conveniences and the effect of an older building stock, in need of refurbishment, there were no savings that could be offered at this time.
- 2.4.5 The Panel did not suggest any changes to the proposed fees and charges.

2.5 General Purposes and Licensing Committee

2.5.1 The Committee recommended that the proposed revenue expenditure bids and savings and proposed fees and charges be agreed.

2.6 Housing, Health and Social Inclusion

2.6.1 The Panel recommended that the proposed revenue expenditure bids and savings, capital expenditure bids and proposed fees and charges be agreed.

2.7 Leisure

- 2.7.1 The Panel recommended to Cabinet:
 - That the proposed revenue expenditure bids and savings be approved.

- That the proposed fees and charges be approved.
- That the proposed capital expenditure plans be approved subject to Option 1 (£200,000) being the preferred option in respect of the Hordle Cliff Path.

2.8 Planning Development Control Committee

2.8.1 Members resolved that no comment be made to the Cabinet on the Expenditure Plan proposals and that no other options for reducing net revenue expenditure can be identified for either the short or medium term.

2.9 Standards Committee

2.9.1 The Committee reiterated its previous recommendation that the £2,000 bid for funding for Probity & Ethic training for Town/Parish Councils should be increased to £6,000. Members emphasised the necessity for sufficient training to minimise the risk of future complaints, the costs of which could easily outweigh the training budget bid.

3. FEES AND CHARGES

3.1 Cabinet discussed fees and charges for 2007/08 at its November meeting and forwarded proposals to Review Panels and Committees for their comments. No specific comments were made and therefore the proposed charges are now reattached in Appendix 1 for Cabinet to reconsider and make final recommendations to Council.

4. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

4.1 It is recommended that Cabinet consider the comments made by the Panels and Committees and recommend Council to approve the fees and charges for 2007/08, as set out in Appendix 1.
