EXPENDITURE PLAN CONSULTATION

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The process and the timetable for the Expenditure Plans for 2008/09 was included in the Financial Strategy approved by the Council in July 2007. The timetable included consultation with all Review Panels and Committees during November, and for any recommendations or comments arising from those meetings to be reported back to Cabinet in December.
- 1.2 This report includes the comments that the Members of the Review Panels and Committees wish to make to Cabinet.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS / COMMENTS FROM PANELS AND COMMITTEES

- 2.1 Corporate Overview
 - 2.1.1 The Panel had no comments to be reported back to Cabinet.
- 2.2 Crime and Disorder
 - 2.2.1 The Panel supported the contents of the report and in particular wish to register specific support for the future funding of the Anti Social Behaviour officer post, which is currently funded by the Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnership.
- 2.3 Employment, Health & Wellbeing
 - 2.3.1 The Panel had no comments to be reported back to Cabinet.
- 2.4 Environment
 - 2.4.1 The Panel had no comments to be reported back to Cabinet.
- 2.5 General Purposes and Licensing Committee
 - 2.5.1 The Committee supported the contents of the report and in particular supported the bid for the enforcement officer post, which is vital in assisting the Council in undertaking its enforcement duty under the Licensing Act 2003.

2.6 Housing

2.6.1 The Panel had no comments to be reported back to Cabinet.

2.7 Leisure

- 2.7.1 The Panel recommended to Cabinet:
 - That the proposed revenue expenditure bids and savings be approved, including the continuation of the Healthy Living Project, but that officers should pursue further funding contributions from the PCT.
 - That the proposed fees and charges be approved.
 - That the proposed capital expenditure plans be approved subject to the deferral of the Open Space – Fordingbridge Easy Access bid to allow further examination of the Panel into the necessity and the need for the path.

2.8 Planning Development Control Committee

2.8.1 The Committee had no comments to be reported to Cabinet.

2.9 Planning and Transportation

2.9.1 The Panel acknowledged that the lack of available information in many areas made forecasting the financial position difficult and were particularly nervous about the position of Land Charges Income, Concessionary Travel and Planning Delivery Grant. They had no specific comments to report back to Cabinet but requested an update at the January Panel meeting on the three areas mentioned above.

2.10 Standards Committee

2.10.1 The Committee had not met at the time this report was prepared. An oral update will be provided if the Committee agree any comments to be reported to Cabinet.

3 FEES AND CHARGES

- 3.1 Cabinet discussed fees and charges for 2008/09 at its November meeting and forwarded proposals to Review Panels and Committees for their comments. No specific comments were made and therefore the proposed charges, excluding beach huts, but including those detailed elsewhere on this agenda, are now reattached in Appendix 1 for Cabinet to reconsider and make final recommendations to Council.
- 3.2 On 22 November, which was after the Review Panel meeting, the Leisure, Culture and Youth Portfolio Holder met with representatives of the Beach Hut Owners Association. The Association recommended an alternative set of beach hut fee proposals that would generate the same overall level of income. These proposals, together with Cabinet's original proposals are attached as Appendix 2. Cabinet are requested to consider whether they want to amend their original proposals in the light of the owners' recommendations.

4 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 4.1 It is recommended that Cabinet consider the comments made by the Panels and Committees and recommend Council to approve the fees and charges for 2008/09, as set out in Appendix 1.
- 4.2 It is recommended that Cabinet reconsider the proposed fees for beach huts. If Cabinet confirms its original proposals then these should be recommended to Council but if any alterations are recommended by Cabinet then it is recommended that these are referred back to the Review Panel in January for comment.
