6. Delegation of Powers to Officers

Following the repeal of Part 1 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, it is necessary to update the authorisations to issue Environmental Permits, serve Notices i.e. Variation, Suspension or Revocation Notices and enforce the conditions of an Environmental Permit since the re-issue of Permits under Regulations made under the Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999.

RECOMMENDED:

That the following delegation of power be granted:

Pollution Prevention To take all necessary action Head of Public Health and and Control Act and exercise all powers community Safety, or 1999 and any including the issue and Environmental Health amending Statues service of any necessary Managers, or Senior and Regulations Environmental Health Officer, or authorisation, Notice or Environmental Health Officer. permit, the inspection of premises and the enforcement of the relevant legislation for the purposes of the Act.
