The Council operates an extensive scheme of delegation of powers to officers, which allows decisions to be taken quickly and efficiently within defined polices.

For operational reasons it is necessary to authorise additional persons to be able to enter on land to assess potentially dangerous trees. The National Park Authority's tree team, who look after this Council's responsibilities in respect of protected trees, have agreed to undertake site visits to assess potentially dangerous trees on the Council's behalf and report back to the Council's officers with their findings. The National Park Authority's tree team therefore require authorisation from the Council to do this.
