The following decisions were taken at the above meeting:

Agenda Item 5 – Reports of Cabinet and Committee

The recommendations arising from the meetings of the Cabinet on 3 December and of the General Purposes and Licensing Committee on 8 December were agreed.

Agenda Item 7 – Questions Under Standing Order 22A

The following questions were asked of Portfolio Holders. The Portfolio Holders' responses will be available in the minutes: -

- The Planning & Transportation Portfolio Holder was asked what action was proposed against a company to make good damage to Cockleydown Copse in Totton.
- The Planning & Transportation Portfolio Holder was asked whether the District Council would seek to prevent future cuts to bus subsidies which were impacting on vulnerable people.
- The Planning & Transportation Portfolio Holder was questioned about the tendering process for new parking meters and provision for alternative payment methods.
- The Housing & Communities Portfolio Holder was asked about the need for key working housing near Fordingbridge Hospital and proposed action in this regard.
- The Leader of the Council was asked what steps had been taken to stimulate interest among young people in voting and elections.
- The Housing & Communities Portfolio Holder was asked about the Police's recording of crime and for her views on the crime statistics in the next year.
- The Leader of the Council was asked about the Council's position on the MOD consulting local people on the future of the Marchwood Sea Mounting Centre, and whether the Council would support calls for a public inquiry.
