The Chairman of the Council (Cllr Cooke) in the Chair.

1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

Cllr Cooke moved that Cllr Hutchins be elected Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year.

The motion was seconded by Cllr Greer and a number of members spoke in support.

RESOLVED:

That Cllr Hutchins be elected Chairman of the Council to continue in office until his successor becomes entitled to act as Chairman at the next annual meeting of the Council on 18 May 1998.

Cllr Hutchins took the Chair and made the declaration of acceptance of office, which was formally witnessed by the Director of Finance and Administration.

Cllr Cooke invested the Chairman with the chain and badge of office. Cllr Cooke also invested the Chairman's consort with her badge of office and presented her with a basket of flowers.

On behalf of the staff, the Managing Director congratulated the Chairman on his election.

The Chairman thanked his fellow members for his election and pledged to uphold the respect and dignity due to the position, without allowing party politics to attach to the role.

2. VOTE OF THANKS TO CLLR COOKE.

It was moved by the Chairman of the Council, seconded and unanimously

RESOLVED:

That the best wishes of this Council be recorded to Cllr Cooke for her outstanding service during her term of office as Chairman of the Council and that she be wished every success for the future.

Members spoke of the way in which Cllr Cooke had undertaken her duties on behalf of the District. She had earned universal respect and had proved to be a fair and impartial Chairman.

On behalf of all the staff, the Managing Director expressed his thanks and good wishes to Cllr Cooke. The staff had appreciated the interest she had shown in them.

Cllr Cooke thanked her fellow councillors for allowing her to undertake the role of Chairman during the preceding year.

The Chairman presented Cllr Cooke with a past Chairman's badge and, in the absence of her consort, a past consort's badge. He also presented her with a photograph album depicting events from her year in office, a civic plaque and a basket of flowers.

(a) Election Results

The Chairman was pleased to announce that Miss A Righton, a Senior Environmental Health Officer in the Community Services Directorate, had had a successful kidney transplant.

(c) Hampshire County Structure Plan

It was with regret that the Chairman reported that some of the recommendations in the Panel's report of the Examination in Public into the review of the Hampshire County Structure Plan would have a serious impact on this District if approved. The recommendations would be very strongly resisted by the Council.
