

## **COUNCIL - 11 JUNE 2001**

## BY-ELECTION FOR DISTRICT COUNCIL BASHLEY WARD - 7 JUNE 2001 - REPORT OF THE RETURNING OFFICER

- 1. An election to fill the vacancy for the Bashley Ward of New Forest District Council, caused by the resignation of former Councillor Mrs Delia Wood, was held on 7 June 2001. The election was combined with the election of a Member of Parliament for the New Forest West Constituency and for a member of Hampshire County Council for the Milford and Hordle Division.
- 2. Two candidates were validly nominated for the election Jill Lauran Cleary, the Conservative Party Candidate, and Margaret Rose Newlands, Liberal Democrat.
- 3. The following votes were cast for each candidate -

Jill Lauran Cleary 2,186 Margaret Rose Newlands 1,638

Jill Lauran Cleary has therefore been declared duly elected a Councillor for the Bashley Ward of New Forest District Council.

4. The percentage poll was 59.65%.
