

## ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING – 19 MAY 2003

### DISTRICT, PARISH AND TOWN COUNCIL ELECTIONS 1 MAY 2003 – REPORT OF THE RETURNING OFFICER

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The quadrennial elections for members of the District Council and Parish and Town Councils in New Forest District took place on 1 May 2003. The elections were the first held on the new ward boundaries determined by the Local Government Commission following a review of the electoral arrangements in the District completed in July 2000. The size of the Council increased to 60 with effect from the 1 May elections. A number of changes to the sizes of Parish and Town Councils also took effect from 1 May.

1.2 Notices of election for the 60 seats on the District Council and the 340 seats on the Parish and Town Councils were published on 24 March 2003. After the period allowed for withdrawals, the total number of candidates remaining validly nominated were:

District Council - 129  
Parish/Town Councils - 345

1.3 At the elections in May 1999, there were 135 candidates for District Council seats and 366 for Parish/Town Councils.

#### 2. POLLS – 1 MAY 2003

2.1 There were contests in every District Ward but 212 Parish/Town candidates were elected unopposed. There were polls in the following Parishes/Towns or their wards:

- 2.2 Polling took place at 105 polling stations across the District. Postal ballot papers were issued to 5,540 electors, with 3,885 returning papers.
- 2.3 The overall percentage poll for the District Council elections was 32.99%. This is lower than the 35.51% at the 1999 elections. The highest percentage poll was 50.19% at Downlands and Forest Ward, and the lowest was at Totton North with 19.28%.
- 2.4 The highest percentage poll at the parish elections was 56.46% at Godshill. The lowest was 19.28% at Totton North.
- 2.5 Counting was done locally at 15 counting centres following the close of poll.

### **3. RESULTS**

- 3.1 The results for the elections for the District wards are at Appendix 1.
- 3.2 A summary of the results of the elections for Parish/Town Councillors is set out at Appendix 2. Where insufficient nominations were received to fill all the vacant seats, the Parish or Town Council may within 35 days of the election, co-opt members to fill the vacancies. Any person co-opted must meet the normal qualification rules for membership of a Parish or Town Council. If co-option is not undertaken within 35 days the District Council may appoint persons to serve on the parish/town council, or may order further elections to be held to fill the vacancies.
