12. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS.

Major Elvery

The Chairman informed members of the death on 5 June 2006 of ex-NFDC Councillor Major S S Elvery. Major Elvery had been a member of the Council from 1987 until 1995. He had served on a number of Committees and had represented the Council on the Road Safety Council from 1991 until his retirement in 1995. Members stood in silence in memory of the late Major Elvery.

Queen's Birthday Honours

The Chairman was pleased to announce that the following four residents of the District had been recognised in the Queen's birthday honours: -

- (1) Michael Hunter, from Brockenhurst, head of the shipping safety branch of the Southampton based Maritime and Coastguard Agency had received an OBE for services for the protection of the marine environment.
- (2) David Chisnall, from Langley, was deputy chairman of Totton-based ASFARE Group (a fire safety company), had received an OBE for his contribution to the fire and rescue equipment industry.
- (2) Juliette Spiller, from Minstead, had been awarded an MBE for her services to SSAFA the organisation that provides financial and emotional support to the families of servicemen and women.
- (3) Television presenter Esther Rantzen who lived in the New Forest, had been awarded a CBE in recognition of her charity work and services to young people.

Members also congratulated the Deputy Chief Constable, Ian Readhead, who had been awarded the Queen's Police Medal for outstanding contribution to the police service.

The Chairman wished Tina Harwood the very best of luck in her new role as Personal Assistant to the Head of Planning. Tina had served as the members' secretary for 10 years. She joined the Council in 1989 and had shown loyalty and commitment in her role. Members congratulated her on her appointment and extended best wishes for the future.
