- 2. The following votes were cast for each candidate:

Frances Carpenter (Conservative) - 990 Peter Dance (Labour) - 48 Wynford Davies (Liberal Democrat) - 426 Jeremy May (Independent) - 277

Cllr Carpenter has therefore been declared duly elected a Councillor for the Barton Ward of New Forest District Council.

- 3. The percentage poll was 36.7%
- 4. Cllr Carpenter has given notice of her intention to join the Conservative Group on the Council.
