

## ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING – 21 MAY 2007

### DISTRICT, PARISH AND TOWN COUNCIL ELECTIONS 3 MAY 2007 – REPORT OF THE RETURNING OFFICER

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The quadrennial elections for members of the District Council and Parish and Town Councils in New Forest District took place on 3 May 2007. The elections were the first to be held following the implementation of the Electoral Administration Act 2006. The Act introduced several amendments to certain areas of the legislation governing elections, the most significant of which related to the requirement to check postal voters' signatures and dates of birth.

1.2 Notices of election for the 60 seats on the District Council and the 342 seats on the Parish and Town Councils were published on 22 March 2007. After the period allowed for withdrawals, the total number of candidates remaining validly nominated were:

District Council - 129  
Parish/Town Councils - 386

1.3 At the elections in May 2003, there were 129 candidates for District Council seats and 345 for Parish/Town Councils.

1.4 The polls for the election of a District Councillor for the Bramshaw, Copythorne North and Minstead ward, and a Town Councillor for the Totton North Ward of Totton and Eling Town Council, were abandoned due to the death of one of the candidates. Fresh elections are being held on 14 June 2007.

#### 2. POLLS – 3 MAY 2007

2.1 There were contests in every District Ward and in 14 parishes/towns. 151 Parish/Town candidates were elected unopposed in 23 parishes/towns. There were polls in the following parishes/towns:

- 2.2 Polling took place at 102 polling stations across the District. Another three polling stations were due to open but did not do so because of the countermanding of the polls. Postal ballot papers were issued to 14,686 electors, with 10,891 postal papers being included in the count. The figure of 10,891 excludes 235 papers issued to voters in the Bramshaw, Copythorne North and Minstead ward where the poll was countermanded. Approximately 1.2% of the postal votes returned were rejected on opening because of incorrectly completed, or no, postal voting statements, signatures and dates of birth not matching, no ballot papers, or other irregularities. These postal votes were not included in the count.
- 2.3 The overall percentage poll for the District Council elections was 38.62%. This is higher than the 32.99% at the 2003 elections. The highest percentage poll was 52.68% at Downlands & Forest Ward, and the lowest was at Holbury & North Blackfield Ward with 28%.
- 2.4 The highest percentage poll at the parish elections was 61.8% at Rockbourne. The lowest was 28% at Fawley (Calshot & Holbury Wards).
- 2.5 Counting took place at Applemore Health and Leisure Centre on Friday, 4 May 2007.

### **3. RESULTS**

- 3.1 The results for the elections for the District wards are at Appendix 1.
- 3.2 A summary of the results of the elections for Parish/Town Councillors is set out at Appendix 2. Where insufficient nominations were received to fill all the vacant seats, the Parish or Town Council may within 35 days of the election, co-opt members to fill the vacancies. Any person co-opted must meet the normal qualification rules for membership of a Parish or Town Council. If co-option is not undertaken within 35 days the District Council may appoint persons to serve on the parish/town council, or may order further elections to be held to fill the vacancies.
