#### REPORT OF CABINET

(Meeting held on 3 December 2008)

# 1. PROPOSED EXTENSIONS TO THE COUNCIL'S PUBLIC CCTV SYSTEM (REPORT A) (MINUTE NO. 75)

The Cabinet has agreed, subject to the recommendation below, that the Council's public CCTV system will be extended to Hythe and New Milton to give both areas a hub, monitoring capabilities and 7 cameras at the locations as set out in Report A to the Cabinet.

Over the past few years the communities of Hythe and New Milton have been identified as areas that will benefit from the installation of CCTV. The local communities, businesses and town councils wholeheartedly support these proposals. CCTV will provide an important tool in dealing with anti social behaviour and the installation work will be started at the earliest opportunity.

#### **RECOMMENDED:**

That a capital sum of £340,871 be agreed in the current financial year for the proposed extensions to the Council's Public CCTV system together with additional annual ongoing revenue funding of £56,189 (individual revenue contributions will be received from Hythe and New Milton town councils) for forthcoming years.

# 2. STRATEGIC HEALTH AUTHORITY CONSULTATION – FLUORIDATION OF WATER IN SOUTHAMPTON AND SOUTH EAST HAMPSHIRE (REPORT B) (MINUTE NO. 76)

The Cabinet has agreed a response, as detailed in Report B to them, to a consultation by the South Central Strategic Health Authority on a proposal to introduce fluoride into the water supply of Southampton and the east of the New Forest. The Cabinet has also considered a Notice of Motion submitted to the Council on 21 July 2008 proposing that the water supply in the district should remain unchanged.

The Cabinet's response is based on the work undertaken by the Employment Health and Wellbeing Review Panel and research undertaken by the Health and Wellbeing Portfolio Holder.

The Review Panel considered in full, the evidence that had been gathered by the Hampshire Fluoridation Panel. The Health and Wellbeing Portfolio Holder has read widely on the subject and has considered research both for and against the fluoridation of water.

The Cabinet support the view that mass medication, without choice, for residents is not acceptable. Whilst Southampton City Primary Care Trust is of the view that fluoridation is necessary for the health of children's teeth, the Cabinet agree that other methods such as fluoride toothpaste and better education are more appropriate. The health aspects of fluoridation are not proven and different research on the same evidence gives different answers.

In the light of the conclusions reached by the Employment Health and Wellbeing Review Panel, the Employment Health and Wellbeing Portfolio Holder, the Southampton Overview and Scrutiny Panel and the Hampshire Water Fluoridation Panel, and having fully reviewed the evidence, the response to the consultation conveys the Council's strong support for the water supplies across the region to remain unchanged and urges the Southampton City NHS Primary Care Trust not to add fluoride to the water of Southampton and the affected area of the South East Area of the New Forest.

## 3. NOTICE OF MOTION – SPEED LIMIT ON A31, RINGWOOD (REPORT C) (MINUTE NO. 77)

Following consideration of a Notice of Motion that was presented to the Council on 27 October 2008 the Cabinet has agreed a response to the Highways Agency.

The Planning and Transportation Review Panel initially considered the detail of the Motion and concluded that the most effective way of reducing the number of road casualties was through a package of measures. They agreed that the speed limit should be reduced to 50 mph, as the motion proposed, but that other measures would also contribute towards improving road safety.

The Cabinet supports the wider proposals put forward by the Review Panel and have also taken account of comments from Ringwood Town Council.

The response to the Highways agency will comprise the following points:

- (a) That the Highways Agency be thanked for providing accident information and details of their emerging proposals for the A31;
- (b) That urgent action be requested to be taken to reduce the number and severity of personal injury accidents along the A31 from Picket Post to the Hampshire/Dorset county boundary;
- (c) That the Highways Agency be urged to introduce a package of measures that will improve road safety along the A31 in the Ringwood area and improve conditions for residents near the A31 including:
  - queue detection linked to warning signs to alert drivers to traffic queues ahead within the next 12 months
  - the trial use of road markings (possibly chevrons on the road surface)
     to help drivers to better judge their speed
  - the introduction of a 50 mph speed limit with appropriate enforcement
  - further consultations with the county, district and town councils on the development of detailed proposals to improve or close the West Street link to the A31 subject to such proposals making full provision for ensuring adequate traffic flow arrangements within the town centre.
  - the development of proposals to improve the westbound carriageway
    of the A31 before 2012 by the addition of a westbound traffic lane on
    the A31 west of the "on slip" from the A338/B3347 roundabout so as
    to enable further consultations with the Council and others to be
    undertaken.

(d) That the Highways Agency be asked to inform the Council of its timescale for implementing the above measures and the estimated costs.

## 4. CORPORATE EQUALITY SCHEME 2008-2011 (REPORT D) (MINUTE NO. 78)

The Cabinet is recommending the agreement of a revised Corporate Equalities Scheme for 2008 – 2011 as attached to Report D to them.

The Council adopted the Equality Standard (ES) in 2003/04. A requirement of the ES is for the Council to adopt a Corporate Equality Scheme (CES) to show how the Council's commitment to its Equality Policy will be implemented. It also provides the opportunity to demonstrate how the Council links its statutory equality schemes and duties in respect of race, disability and gender together with other equalities work.

The revised and updated Scheme reflects the recent changes to legislation and the changes to the Equality Standard that will be applicable from 1 April 2009. The revised Scheme also takes account, as far as is possible, changes that might arise if the Equalities Bill 2008 becomes law.

As well as showing the Council's commitment to equalities and diversity the CES shows how it will continue the work of previous years through the next 3 years. The revised Scheme has been widely consulted on with members, the Equality Network, the Equality Advisory Group, Diversity Network partners, employees, Hampshire Equality Network, and other local voluntary and community groups within the district. All the comments received were constructive and supportive and many congratulated the Council on dealing with the topic so comprehensively.

Once the full Scheme has been approved, it is intended to produce a short leaflet to highlight the main aspects of the document, for circulation within the district.

#### **RECOMMENDED:**

That the proposed Corporate Equality Scheme, as attached at Appendix 1 to Report D to the Cabinet, be approved as the Council's Corporate Equality Scheme for 2008-2011.

# 5. FINANCIAL REPORT – FORECAST FULL YEAR AND ACTUAL FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 2008 TO OCTOBER 2008 (REPORT E) (MINUTE NO. 79)

The Cabinet has considered the Council's budget performance for the first seven months of 2008/09 on a portfolio and committee basis and has agreed revised General Fund, Capital Programme and Housing Revenue Account budgets as detailed in Appendices 1-3 to Report E to them.

The shortfall in the budget predicted in the previous monitoring report has now evened out and the budget is currently on course to balance. Whilst the costs for concessionary fares are lower than predicted and interest earnings for 2008/09 are currently projected to increase, the income from planning and land charges fees are reduced.

Members noted that the Council has attracted £700,000 in Government funding to cover the emergency coastal defence repair work at Milford-on-Sea.

# 6. REPRESENTATION ON OUTSIDE BODIES – REVIEW BY CORPORATE OVERVIEW PANEL (REPORT F) (MINUTE NO. 80)

As part of its work programme for 2008, the Corporate Overview Panel has undertaken a review of the Council's representation on outside bodies. In deciding to undertake the review, the Corporate Overview Panel wished to ascertain whether benefits were accruing to the Council from the time and effort spent by members (and in some cases officers) serving on outside bodies as the Council's formal representatives, as well as from the administrative and other costs such as members' travel.

The Cabinet supports the findings of the review which are detailed in Report F to them. They thanked the Panel for proposing a positive set of recommendations that would update the way in which appointments to outside bodies were made.

The Cabinet has also asked the Members' Development Group to consider introducing an informal audit of new members' knowledge and experience to help match individuals to outside body appointments.

### 7. FEES AND CHARGES (REPORT G) (MINUTE NO. 81)

The Cabinet is recommending proposals for fees and charges as detailed in Appendix 1 to this report that have so far been presented to committees and review panels.

Members noted that the Council is approaching the change in VAT in a pragmatic way. The majority of the fees and charges proposed are exclusive of VAT and therefore the lower rate will apply for as long as it is in force. However, all prices quoted inclusive of VAT such as parking charges will remain the same as it is impractical to change these due to their relatively small value, their large range and their method of collection.

#### **RECOMMENDED:**

That, having considered the comments made by Panels and Committees, the fees and charges for 2009/10, as set out in Appendices 1 to 7 to this report be agreed.

# 8. MEDIUM TERM FINANCIAL PLAN – ANNUAL BUDGET 2009/10 (REPORT H) (MINUTE NO. 82)

In the light of the agreed budget strategy for 2009/10, Portfolio Holders have been developing their Plans and undertaking consultation with committees and review panels. The Cabinet has considered the feedback from that consultation.

Two of the Council's main sources of income are from Government grant and council tax and as such there is little room for manoeuvre. Whilst the Council has good reserves, and overall is in a sound financial position, there is still a shortfall in the proposed budget. Whilst it is too early to say if the Council's reserves will need to be used, the Cabinet will only support this course of action, if needed, at the end of the process.

In the light of the work undertaken so far the Cabinet has agreed changed budget assumptions as set out in the Medium Term Financial Plan at Appendix D in Report H to them. The Asset Management Group has also been requested to develop, in the light of the current financial situation, a Capital Programme for consideration by the Cabinet in January.

Portfolio Holders will continue their work with Heads of Services to identify areas where income can be increased and expenditure can be reduced.

# 9. THE COUNCIL TAX 2009/2010 – SETTING THE TAX BASE (REPORT I) (MINUTE NO. 83)

The Cabinet has considered, and in so far as it is empowered to do so by law, approved the calculation of the Council Tax base for the year 2009/10 as set out below. It has decided that pursuant to this report and in accordance with the Local Authorities (Calculation of Council Tax Base) (Amendment) Regulations 2003, the amount calculated by this Council as its council tax base for the year 2009/10 be as follows and as detailed in Appendix 1 to Report I to the Cabinet:

#### 10. SETTLEMENT OF LITIGATION (REPORT J) (MINUTE NO. 85)

The Cabinet has considered, in private session, the detail of an urgent decision taken by the Executive Director (Responsible Finance Officer) in relation to costs awarded against the Council following litigation. In accordance with Financial Regulation 2.4 they noted that the Executive Director (Responsible Finance Officer) had agreed a supplementary estimate in the sum of £90,000 in relation to work undertaken to sport hall floors at Applemore, Totton and Ringwood Health and Leisure Centres.

# 11. APPLEMORE HEALTH AND LEISURE CENTRE CHANGING ROOMS – SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING (REPORT K) (MINUTE NO. 87)

The Cabinet is recommending a request for additional funding to enable the completion of refurbishment work to the wet changing rooms at Applemore Health and Leisure Centre.

The Council currently has a programme of Capital Works designed to make all of its buildings compliant with the requirements of the Disability Discrimination Act. The programme includes works to the changing accommodation at the Health & Leisure Centres including the swimming pool changing rooms at Applemore. The scheme at Applemore was brought forward into 2008/09 to co-ordinate the works with other essential maintenance and thereby minimise the disruption to the public and, to the loss of income during closures.

The tenders originally sought for the scheme were over budget and, following consideration by the Council's Asset Management Group, the scheme was reconfigured and retendered. However, the lowest price received for the work meant a shortfall of £61,500 in funding.

In addition, notification has been received from the Department for Culture, Media and Sport that, as not all local authorities have signed up to the free swimming initiatives, additional funding has been allocated to those authorities that have.

This means that the Council's revenue allocation for free swimming for Under 16's has increased from £77,371 to £93,370 and the one-off Capital grant from £39,500 to £52,630. As a consequence the supplementary funding required to complete the refurbishment work at Applemore Health and Leisure Centre is able to be reduced from £61,500 to £48,370.

#### **RECOMMENDED**

That a supplementary capital estimate of £48,370 in 2009/10 be agreed in order to complete the refurbishment works to the wet changing rooms at Applemore Health and Leisure Centre and that the consequent re-phasing of £153,000 in existing budgets from 2008/09 into 2009/10 be noted.
