1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

Cllr Mrs McEvoy moved that Cllr Ms Ford be elected Chairman of the Council for the ensuing municipal year. The motion was seconded by Cllr Woods.

RESOLVED:

That Cllr Ms Ford be elected Chairman of the Council to continue in office until her successor becomes entitled to act as Chairman at the next annual meeting of the Council.

Cllr Ms Ford took the chair and made the declaration of acceptance of office, which was formally witnessed by the Chief Executive.

Cllr Mrs McEvoy invested the Chairman with the Chain and Badge of Office and presented the Chairman with a bouquet of flowers.

On behalf of employees, the Chief Executive congratulated the Chairman on her election.
