#### 10. STANDARDS REGIME

Hampshire and Isle of Wight Local Authorities Group (HIOWLA) have requested all principal councils to consider reviewing their standards regimes to ensure consistency of approach (and thus minimise confusion, especially for dual-hatted members) in three main areas, by requiring the following:-

- Members to declare interests relating to charitable and public bodies, bodies to which members have been appointed by the authority, and political parties and trade unions.
- 2. Members to declare gifts and hospitality (received in their official capacity) with an estimated value of £50 or over.
- 3. Members who have a statutory Disclosable Pecuniary Interest (DPI) in a matter which is before a meeting, to leave the room (although the law does not require them to).

This Council already has rules within its Standing Orders that deal with point 1 above. With regard to point 2, it would appear sensible to have a Register of Gifts and Hospitality for members to declare items with an estimated value of £50 or over. With regard to point 3, as there is no requirement in law for members to leave the room when they have a DPI (although some members currently do so), it is not proposed at this stage to change the Council's existing rules in this regard.

#### **RECOMMENDED:**

That a Register of Gifts and Hospitality be introduced for members to declare gifts and hospitality (received in an official capacity) with an estimated value of £50 or over.
