### ANY ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED:

To collect refuse on 26 and 27 December or 1 January. Rejected partly for cost and also because the disposal sites would be closed.

# PORTFOLIO HOLDER DECISION

### CHRISTMAS REFUSE COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS 2011/12

### 1. CHRISTMAS REFUSE COLLECTION

1.1 The Portfolio Holder for the Environment proposes to revise the refuse collection arrangements for Christmas 2011 and New Year 2012 in order to accommodate Public Holidays on Monday 26 December 2011 and Tuesday 27 December 2011. The proposed refuse collection arrangements are as follows:

1.2 These proposed arrangements will have the following effect:

MONDAY	No collection on 26 December. Double collection on Monday 2 January.
TUESDAY	No collection on 27 December. Double collection on Tuesday 3 January.
WEDNESDAY	No Change.
THURSDAY	No Change.
FRIDAY	No Change.

- 1.3 The revised refuse collection arrangements for Christmas 2011 have been agreed with Trade Union representatives. There is an additional holiday for New Forest District Council staff on Wednesday 28 December, but the Council's refuse collectors have agreed to work on that day and will receive a day off in lieu at a later time.
- 1.4 To minimise disruption, staff have also agreed to work on Monday 2nd January 2012 which is a Bank Holiday

### 2. REASON

2.1 Although Christmas Day 2011 falls on a Sunday there are Public Holidays on Monday 26 December and Tuesday 27 December 2011. It would be unreasonable to expect the Council's refuse collectors to work on these two public holidays. The proposed revised refuse collection arrangements will inconvenience some New Forest residents but disruption to services at Christmas time is inevitable. These revised arrangements minimise disruption and allow the refuse collection service to get back to normal as quickly as possible.

# 3. ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

- 3.1 Another alternative which has been considered would be to collect refuse on 26 December and 27 December which are Public Holidays. This would require overtime payments to staff. There would be practical difficulties in providing a refuse collection service on these Public Holidays, such as missed collections, problems gaining access to residential areas, noise and disturbance. Refuse collection could only be provided on Public Holidays if Hampshire County Council agreed to open the waste disposal sites.
- 3.2 In previous years staff have worked on the Saturday between Christmas and New Year, but due to New Years Day falling on the Sunday it has been decided that this option is not available to us this year as the disposal points will be closed and there would be an impact on the other collection days that week.
