PORTFOLIO HOLDER DECISION

FEES & CHARGES - ENVIRONMENT

1. ITEM FOR DECISION

As part of the annual review of budgets, decisions are required to agree any non-statutory fees and charges for the forthcoming year.

PORTFOLIO: ENVIRONMENT

2. POLICY FRAMEWORK

The decisions over fees and charges have to be within the constraints of the overall financial framework and the medium term financial plan. At the same time decision making regarding these needs to reflect a 'commercial' environment where there is a need to react swiftly and proactively to changing conditions. As a result power to agree fees and charges or to make formal arrangements for the setting of fees and charges within a Portfolio is delegated to the Portfolio Holder.

3. CONSULTATION UNDERTAKEN

The Head of Service has implemented consultation procedures as appropriate for the various fees and charges applicable and the Portfolio Holder has been involved in the process or been notified of the outcome.

The Portfolio Holder decision has due regard to any issues which have emerged from consultation.

4. OPERATIONAL IMPLICATIONS

The basis of charging for visitor moorings need to be changed to reduce administration and increase accountability. The proposal is to remove the charge per foot and replace this with a fixed rate per mooring type.

These proposals also include issuing 15 month dingy park fees from January 2012 to March 2013 to coincide with new terms of use for the dingy park. These new terms will mean in future years the annual term will run from April to March with owners during a period in December being required to move their dinghy's to an adjacent location to allow the Council to undertake annual maintenance work of the site.

We have removed the commercial waste charges from this process as these are commercial and confidential information which can be used by competitors in this market. The basis for special collections have been revised to encourage more people to use the scheme but to discourage individuals from generating waste items to be removed just because e they have paid for a maximum number of items.

The statutory Declaration transfer fee has been increased for £40 to £80 due to the amount of time spent on these by officers whilst dealing with relatives and solicitors, this figure has been bench marked with other authorities and following a recommendation from the ICCM.

5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Any financial implications will have been or will be reported as part of the ongoing Portfolio Plan and budgetary control.

The Commercial waste charges will be agreed with the Portfolio Holder on a regular basis during the year to meet the needs of the service to make them competitive in the changing market.

6. ENVIRONMENTAL, CRIME & DISORDER AND EQUALITY & DIVERSITY IMPLICATIONS

There are no implications arising directly as a result of this decision. Any impacts as a result of altered service delivery outcomes would have been reflected as part of the Portfolio Plan and budget setting processes.
