PORTFOLIO HOLDER DECISION

CHRISTMAS REFUSE COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS 2012/13

1. CHRISTMAS REFUSE COLLECTION

1.1 The Portfolio Holder for the Environment proposes to revise the refuse collection arrangements for Christmas 2012 and New Year 2013 in order to accommodate Public Holidays on Tuesday 25th December 2012, Wednesday 26thDecember 2012 and Tuesday 1st January 2013. The proposed refuse collection arrangements are as follows:

- 1.2 These proposed arrangements will have the following effect:

REFUSE COLLECTION DAY	REVISED ARRANGEMENTS
MONDAY	Normal Monday Collections.
TUESDAY	No collection on 25th December or 1 st January. Double collection on Wednesday 2 January.
WEDNESDAY	No Collection on Wednesday 26 th December. Double collection on Thursday 3 rd January
THURSDAY	3 rd January collection moved to Friday 4 th January
FRIDAY	4 th January Collection moved to Saturday 5 th January.

- 1.3 The revised refuse collection arrangements for Christmas 2012/13 have been agreed with Trade Union representatives. There is an additional holiday for New Forest District Council staff on Monday 24th December 2012, but the Council's refuse collectors have agreed to work on that day and will receive a day off in lieu at a later time.
- 1.4 To minimise disruption, staff have also agreed to work on Saturday 5th January 2013

2. REASON

2.1 It would be unreasonable to expect the Council's refuse collectors to work on these three public holidays. The proposed revised refuse collection arrangements will inconvenience some New Forest residents but disruption to services at Christmas time is inevitable. These revised arrangements minimise disruption and allow the refuse collection service to get back to normal as quickly as possible.

3. ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

3.1 Another 3 alternatives were considered by unions and the Portfolio Holder. This would require overtime payments to staff to work over some of the bank holidays. There would be practical difficulties in providing a refuse collection service on these Public Holidays, such as missed collections, problems gaining access to residential areas, noise and disturbance. Refuse collection could only be provided on Public Holidays if Hampshire County Council agreed to open the waste disposal sites.
