FINANCE AND EFFICIENCY PORTFOLIO HOLDER DECISION: SEPTEMBER 2011

ALLOCATION OF DEVELOPERS CONTRIBUTIONS FOR A SPORTSWALL AT TESTWOOD RECREATION GROUND

ITEM FOR DECISION

The request is from Totton and Eling Town Council for the allocation of developers' contributions for open space to provide a purpose built "sportswall" at Testwood Recreation Ground. This site is popular with casual users but there is no kick about provision. Young people are using the wall of the pavilion as a rebound wall, which is not appropriate. After consultation with the young people, the need for a proper "sportswall" was identified. This facility has options for football, tennis, cricket, netball and basketball and being open access and free of charge, will have wide benefits.

POLICY FRAMEWORK

Testwood Recreation Ground is an established and essential part of public open space in the Town. The proposal will enhance the use of an existing facility, to better meet the needs of the community.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

The sum requested is £14,000, within a total cost of £15,000. An award of £1,000 has been secured from the Hampshire Playing Fields Association. There are sufficient funds in the total amounts held in developer's contributions for this proposal to take place.

CONSULTATION INPUT

There has been direct feedback from the young people who are users of the site. Consultation has been undertaken with local members and appropriate members of the Community Overview and Scrutiny Panel. Comments are as set out in the consultation returns.

PROPOSED DECISION

That an allocation of £14,000 be made from developers' contributions for open space held for the benefit of Totton and Eling, to enable the construction of a "sportswall" at Testwood Recreation Ground.
