**Item 6 – Delegations**

Section 52 of the Road Safety Act 2006 (which amends Part 2 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provision) Act 1976) gives power to suspend or revoke a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire vehicle drivers' licence with immediate effect where it is in the interest of public safety to do so.

The Committee are asked to agree the following delegations: -

- (a) To Authorise the Assistant Director (Environmental Health) and the Environmental Health Manager (Commercial) to suspend a taxi or private hire vehicle drivers' licence with immediate effect where they are of the opinion that the interests of public safety require such a course of action; and
- (b) To Authorise the Assistant Director (Environmental Health) and the Environmental Health Manager (Commercial) in consultation with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Committee, to revoke a taxi or private hire vehicle drivers' licence with immediate effect where they are of the opinion that the interests of public safety require such a course of action.
