

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS 2007/08 AND PROPOSED KEY TARGETS 2008/09

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Each year the council identifies its key targets for the year ahead and assesses performance against them. Key targets are identified to reflect the high impact or most important activities for the council in the coming year as well providing a focus on outcomes. They are monitored during the year and reported against the corporate plan in the council's annual performance plan, *Performance Matters*
- 1.2 This report seeks the panel's input into the:
 - Assessment of achievements against key targets for 2007/08
 - Proposed key annual targets for 2008/09
- 1.3 The 2008/09 draft key targets have, in the main, been identified through the high priority areas within the service improvement plans. These will also be discussed with portfolio holders and the senior management team before final agreement by cabinet
- 1.4 It is important that all targets coming forward are appropriate and SMART. This means they should be: Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic and Timerelated. Unless otherwise stated any target for 2008/09 without a specific date will aim to be completed by March 2009.
