FEES AND CHARGES – 2014/15

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This report sets out the suggested fees and charges for 2014/15 for Council services forming part of the General Purposes and Licensing Committee. The report forms part of the Council's medium term financial plan and annual budget for 2014/15.

 - 2.3 The proposed increase in fees and charges are based on an increase indicator of between 2.7 3.2% to take into account the current rate of inflation where possible. In some cases the proposed increase is greater than the recommended indicator.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The proposed fees and charges, detailed in Appendix 1 have been set principally in accordance with the Council's charging policy and financial targets for 2014/15. Where possible, opportunities have been taken to maximise income. In some areas charges have not been raised in order to safeguard demand levels or because statutory constraints require the charge to be set at predetermined levels.
