Milford-on-Sea Parish Council wish to register its **very strong objection** to the recent licensing application for the Red Lion Public House.

The Parish Council is concerned that the suggested extension of hours will lead to a breach in the following licence conditions:

Condition 1: Will create intolerable crime and disorder problems. This is a local village pub in a quiet and undisturbed area amidst residential properties and is in the centre of the Conservation Area. The extra hours will inevitably attract customers from much further afield and will create trouble in the early hours when public transport has ceased.

Condition 2: Will affect Public Safety. At last year's Carnival which attracted numerous people from the surrounding area there were many Public Safety fears voiced by local residents. Indeed there was a serious assault and as a result of Police advice the Carnival activities this year will terminate at 8.00pm.

Condition 3: Cause a Public Nuisance. The pub is centrally located and thus surrounded by residents who will be greatly disturbed by the late hours.



As you the council have granted me planning permission in 2004 for the redevelopment of the site with new shop and flats above, the possibility of music being played to the early hours of the morning would be unacceptable for the persons who may rent or purchase the flats when they are built.

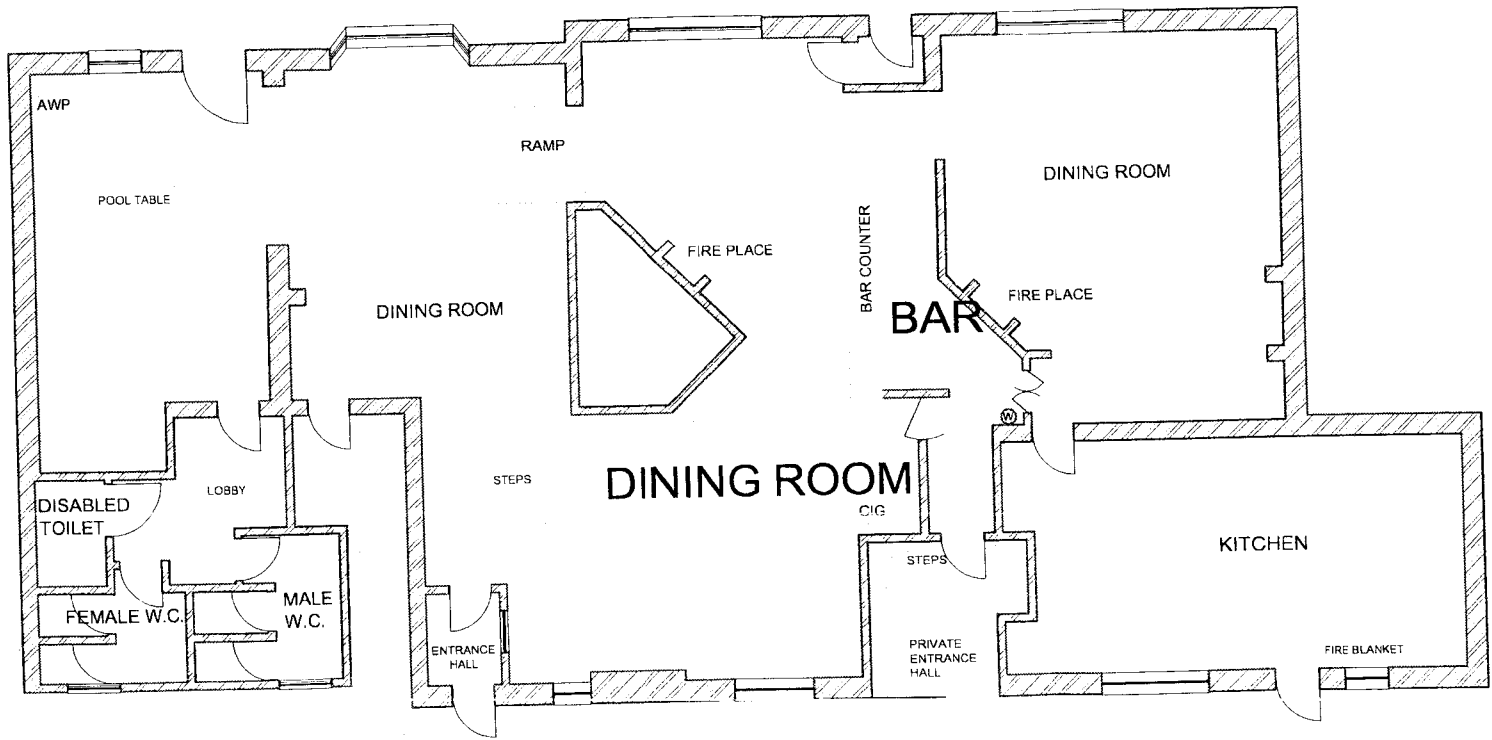
