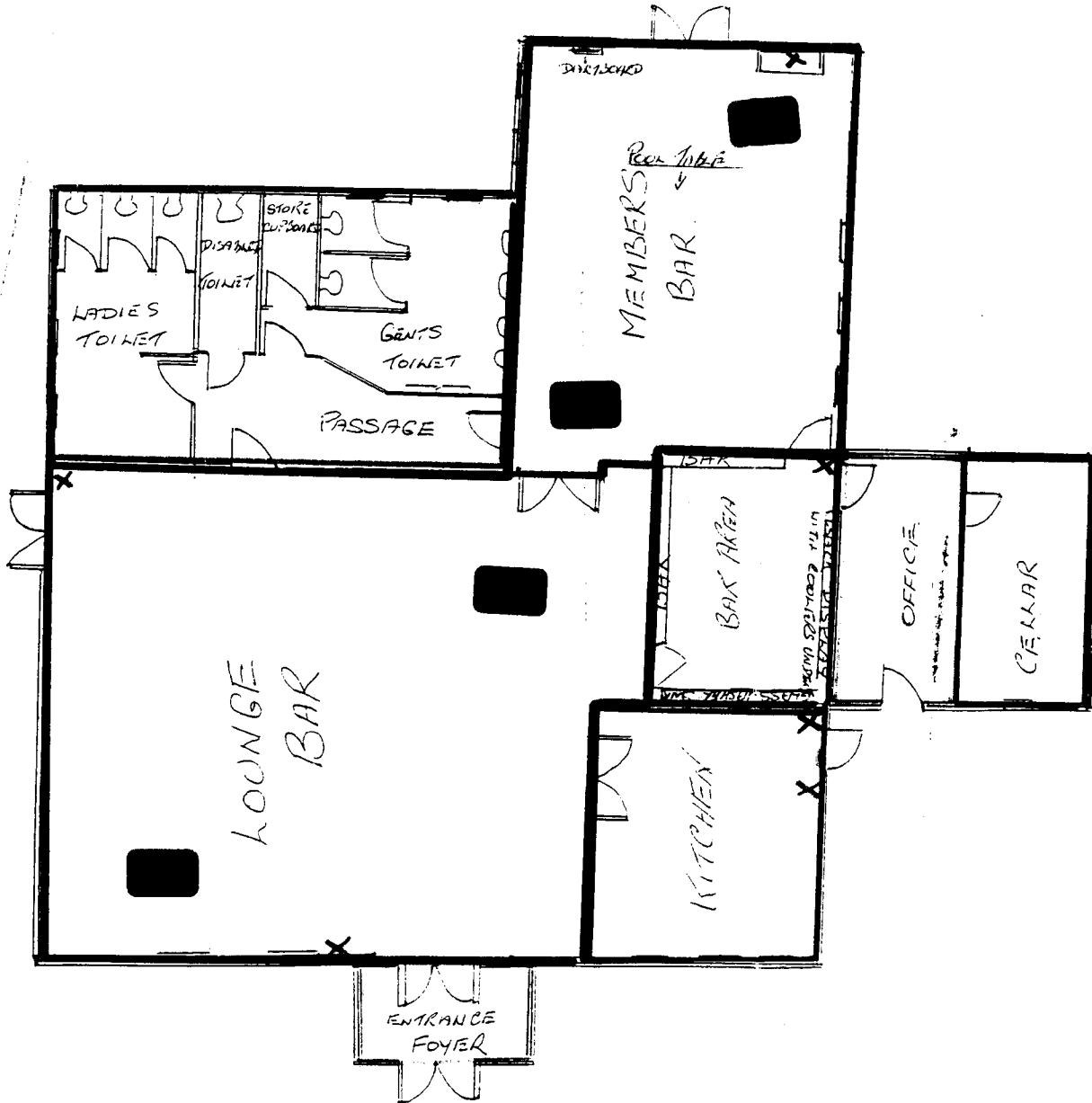

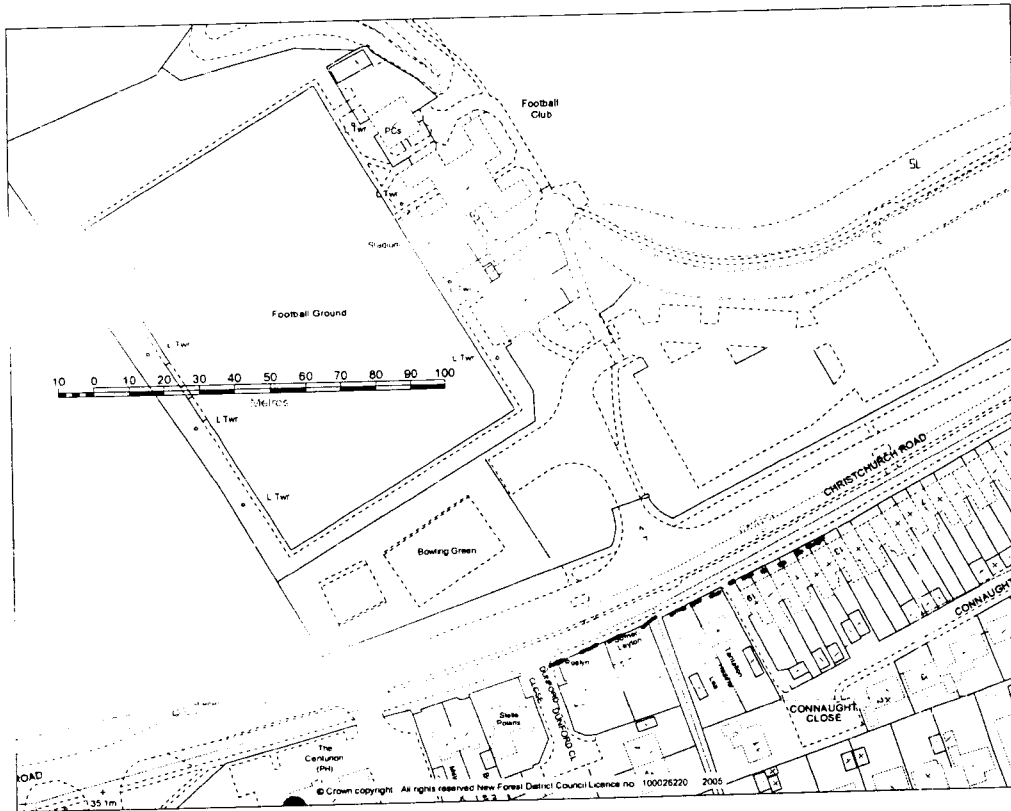

Fridays - Saturdays - 10.00 - 0030 hrs

Sunday 11.00 - 2300 hrs.

Recently, yet again, many of our cars have been damaged (9. 07. 05. 10.30pm) and it was necessary to call the police. Nine wing mirrors had been kicked off and Mr. B. McHugh - 7 Christchurch Road, actually witnessed 2 youths kicking the cars, legitimately parked in the service road. This type of activity is not unusual. Gates have been removed from some of the houses as have bicycles been stolen. The noise of drunken young people, screaming, singing, swearing, hurling beer cans into our gardens will, no doubt increase.

We do not suggest that most of this trouble comes from the Sports Club but longer hours; more trouble will result, when people return from the Club. We ask you to note that this row of houses are not 'second homes' and all of us

would appreciate a quiet weekend, especially late at night or even worse, early morning.

One of the undersigned had his car tyres, and wheels removed on one occasion and another, since moved, had a stone garden ornament thrown through his windscreen.
