When weather is fairly still or a breeze is blowing from an approximately westerly direction, sound carries very clearly across the valley. We will often hear activities at the park late at night.

Entertainment from midnight to 3am is likely to extremely unpleasant on most summer evenings making sleep difficult.

For this reason we wish to object to the granting of a license for entertainment from midnight onward.

We see no reason to object to entertainment till midnight provided that such entertainment does not become a nuisance.

As I will be in Australia on business on 12 Sept I will be unable to attend a hearing. My wife will be complete degree examination work so is also unavailable. We may be unable to secure representation for this day.
