The types of indoor sporting events entertainment and provision of late night refreshment is proposed to re-instate and enhance the nomal public house entertainments that were previously unregulated, with the added benefit of the ocassional live and recorded music with dancing to broaden the experience when attending the premises and reduce the focus on alcohol.

Not less than 10 working days written notice will be provided to the police before an Occassional Licence as detailed in part B1 above is used.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises will provide a 30 minute extension to opening hours after the end of the sale of alcohol to promote this objective as the last drink will be consumed less quickly and customers can then leave in an orderly fashion and make use of the toilet facilities before departure. This will also assist in minimising public nuisance.

The premises adopts the Portman Group Code of practice "Avoiding the Encouragment of Excessive Consumption in Multi-Purchase, on Trade Promotions by Producers" and the Gudiance issued by the British Beer & Pub Association on point of sale promotions. We would like to register our objection to requested applications to amend the licensing laws on the following grounds:

1. This premise has been extensively enlarged by converting accommodation into trade area. We understood the enlargement would not result in packing problems as restaurants effectively have less customers per square meter and thus parking would not be effected.

However this licensing implies that its restaurant status may well change and thus more cars and no parking. Please note access is via a single carriageway lane that if blocked prevents emergency services to the properties beyond.

2. We had in the past asked if the beer garden be reinstated to the opposite side of the building as per pre-restaurant days. However this was ignored so we now overlook the out side eating area, which is on occasion noisy late into the evening. However if out doors music allowed, this would cause a great disturbance to us as direct neighbours and I feel would ultimately result in conflict.

We hope you give this matter careful thought.

We wish to make representations concerning the above in respect of the following two licensing objectives specified in the Licensing Act 2003:

The prevention of public nuisance

The premises are in a designated countryside area (New Forest Local Plan). There needs to be limitations on the level of noise allowed in respect of both indoor and outdoor music to take this into account. We understand that guidance on this act makes it clear that "public" refers equally to general public and neighbours.

Public Safety

The premises are, at present, under utilised but this application, by requesting outdoor music and dancing, makes it clear that more intensive use is envisaged. The car park, although possibly complying with County Council Highway standards, would be inadequate for more intensive use. Overflow car parking in the narrow unlit lane would create public safety hazards both in respect of danger to pedestrians and obstruction of emergency services. A general traffic hazard would also result from increased use of the lane which is single track, with no designated passing places, has inadequate sight lines at the junction with Frost Lane.

At present it appears that there is no statutory site notice.
