I have been asked to comment on your clients licence application with regards to public nuisance.

I note from their application that they are applying for to increase the hours of regulated entertainment from 0700 to 0200 seven days a week. I note that there is no previous PEL at the venue and no evidence supplied on the suitability of the premises to hold such events. Moreover, no additional controls have been offered to controls any potential public nuisance.

I am concerned that there is potential for noise nuisance to be caused by the holding of such regulated entertainment **unless** suitable controls are in place at the venue. May I refer you to Section C, the prevention of public nuisance, of the Licensing Policy 2003. (7<sup>th</sup> January 2005). A copy of this document is available at [www.nfdc.gov.uk](http://www.nfdc.gov.uk).

I would like you to consider adding the following controls to your operating schedule. These are designed to minimise the impact of these activities on the local community. I would like you to consider the following conditions:

*. The licence holder or nominated representative shall receive and respond to complaints throughout the duration of the regulated entertainment.*

*. After 2300, music and noise emanating from the premises shall be inaudible at the*

*boundary of all noise sensitive premises.*
