    - (b) any occasion within paragraph 8(3) (d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act)
- (c) For the purposes of this section –
  - (i) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
  - (ii) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule

I live at the above address, which is adjacent and over looking the car park of the Heath Hotel public house in Dibden Purlieu.

Having just returned from holiday I was perturbed to discover that a notice was displayed in a window of the Heath Hotel explaining their intention to apply for a license extension to serve drinks until 12:30 AM all week to include entertainment, unfortunately I also noticed that today, 05/09/05 was the last day for written objections to be received. Having contacted yourselves by telephone I am now faxing my objection to you.

My objection is as follows, the main problem we experience from the Heath Hotel is at closing time, at present 11:00 PM, 10:30 PM on Sunday, customers leave the pub anything up to midnight shouting their farewells across the car park and sounding their hooters as they leave the premises, sometimes these revellers are parked directly under our bedroom window, remaining there with the engine running and radio playing . The problem is worse during the summer when on hot evenings we have to open our windows and customers sit in the pub garden, getting louder the more they drink, before leaving well after closing time, the worse leaving time we experienced this year was just after midnight. An additional problem is the car park flood lights which shine directly into our windows and are sometimes left on all night.

I am extremely concerned that should this extension be allowed the problems, already being experienced, will then be suffered at possibly 1:30 in the morning by not only myself but several other houses skirting the pub premises including the retirement flats directly above the pub garden.

I hope that my objection will receive your consideration.
