

I am writing in respect of the proposed variation of club premises certificate for:
Hythe and District Club
26 Pylewell Road
Hythe
SO45 6AQ

I live at 14 School Road, which is about 40 yards away from the Club in a residential street of about 14 houses near the club. The street also includes a school but there is no noise and disturbance from the school after 3.30pm.

I should like to object to the proposed extension to the hours to 00.30 Mon-Sat on the grounds that young members that have had too much to drink come along the road after closing and have in the past made excessive noise, kicked cars, shouted at each other and had fights among themselves.

I have been living in this house since September 2003 and I have noticed a steady increase in the amount of noise and distruptive behaviour at closing time, especially on a Friday and Saturday night after 11.00.

If the hours are extended then there is a likelyhood of two possibilites: 1. a potentail increase in the behaviour due to longer time to consume alcohol 2. the time at which such behaviour takes place, even if there is no increase in frequency, will be after 00.30 or past my normal bedtime.

As it is I find the noise a nuisance. There have been occasions when these young people have stopped to have a discussion or row right outside the house. I have put up with it rather then risk confrontation and potential risk to myself and my property. I fear the situation will get worse with an extension to the hours.

I hope you will consider this objection carefully.

CLUB PREMISES CERTIFICATE

EMBEDDED RESTRICTIONS Transferred from the licensing act 1964

1. Permitted Hours

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. In this condition, permitted hours means:

- On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- On Sundays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m.
- c. On Good Friday, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m.
- d. On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- e. On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m.
- f. On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).
- g. On Christmas day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the chairman or secretary of the club to the chief executive of the justices for the petty sessions area in which the premises are. The said hours shall:
 - not exceed six and a half hours;
 - ii. not begin earlier than 12 noon;
 - iii. not end later than 10.30 p.m.
 - iv. provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.;
 - v. not extend for more than three and a half hours after 5 p.m.

MANDATORY CONDITIONS Attached to the Club Premises Certificate by virtue of the Licensing Act 2003

- Mandatory Conditions Where the Club Premises Certificate Authorises the Supply of Alcohol for Consumption Off the Premises
- (a) Where a club premises certificate authorises the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises, the licence must include the following conditions:
- (b) The first condition is that the supply must be made at a time when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club premises certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- (c) The second condition is that any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- (d) The third condition is that any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

2. Mandatory Conditions: Exhibition of Films

- (a) Where a club premises certificate authorises the exhibition of films, the licence must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with this section.
- (b) Where the film classification body is specified in the certificate, unless subsection (3)(b) applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that body
- (c) Where -
 - (a) The film classification body is not specified in the certificate, or
 - (b) The relevant licensing authority has notified the club which holds the certificate that this subsection applies to the film in question,

admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority

(d) In this section -

"children" means persons aged under 18; and "film classification body" means the person or persons designated as the authority under Section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (c.39) (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification)
