7. Reasons for the Decision

The Sub-Committee carefully considered the evidence, both written and oral, supplied by the parties and has decided to grant the application.

Following the Applicant's decision to further reduce the hours for the sale of alcohol to 7 am to 10 pm (and not 7 am to midnight which they originally applied for), the Sub-Committee felt that these hours would not be detrimental to the Licensing Objectives. They were mindful of the objectors' views at the Hearing that things had considerably improved, in terms of reduced public nuisance and crime and disorder since the arrival of Tesco's and they were content with the reduced hours of selling alcohol which Tesco had now applied for.

The Sub-Committee considered all the other representations and felt that the hours now proposed were reasonable and not detrimental to the Licensing Objectives.
