Hampshire Constabulary have an **objection** to the variation of premises licence for the Roebuck, Marchwood Village Centre, on the grounds of crime and disorder.

It is our view that the licensable hours Sunday to Thursday should remain the same as the existing premises licence and are in keeping with the village location the pub occupies.

- 1 The first proposed variation is to increase the licensable activities at the premises to 01:00 hours (the following morning) each Friday and Saturday (plus 30mins "drinking up time). The applicant does not indicate any additional measures in ensuring the prevention of crime and disorder both at the premises and in respect of customers leaving the premises, the locality, which is in the village centre and is surrounded by residential dwellings. It is the view of Hampshire Police that all licensable activities should cease, at the latest, by midnight each Friday and Saturday evening. This would mean that having allowed for 30 mins "drinking up time" that customers would be leaving the premises by 23.30 during the week and 00.30 on Saturday/Sunday mornings. Given the setting of the pub in the centre of a village with many nearby residences we feel that any later would be wholly innapropriate and out of keeping with the area. We believe that late opening hours would also encourage people to come from other pubs in the locality who close earlier giving rise to a risk of increased crime and disorder.
- 2 Timings for late night refreshment should mirror those for supply of alcohol each Friday and Saturday.

In relation to the removal of conditions on the licence (3, 4 & 5)

No alternative solutions/conditions have been put forward on the application form as to how the Licensee will ensure 'good order' at the premises (Section 7.1 - 10 inclusive, and section 10.8 - 10 inclusive). It is the view of Hampshire Constabulary that these conditions are still very relevant and should remain on the licence.


