Dear Sir,

Re: Application for Premises Licence at Moortown Service Station, Ringwood

I am writing to object to the above application to permit the selling of alcohol at the above premises.

I live opposite the Service Station and my objections are as follows:-

- There have been attempted break-ins at the Service Station evidenced by the alarm sounding during the night on several occasions. The presence of alcohol would attract further crime of this nature.
- Groups of young people sometimes congregate at the Service Station late at night, usually shouting and disturbing the peace. If they were able to buy alcohol this behaviour would increase and intensify.
- There are no parking bays on the forecourt. This application would encourage more customers who may park on the busy B3347 causing obstructions to the access to our drive and other road users.
- The Station is situated on the corner of a major junction with potential hazards. Attracting more custom and traffic will cause further congestion and potential accidents in this semi-rural residential area.

Having lived here for over seven years and seen the volume of traffic along Christchurch Road steadily increasing, I feel I am in a position to outline these objections.
