The prevention of crime and disorder

A CCTV system will be maintained which is fit for the purpose. The CCTV system will incorporate recording facilities and any recording will be retained and stored in a suitable manner for a reasonable period of time. The CCTV system will be maintained and fully operational throughout the hours that the premises are open for any licensable activities. The precise position of the cameras may be agreed with the police from time to time.

Public safety

We have conduct of suitable fire risk assessment at the premises and implemented the necessary control measures including safe evacuation of disabled people. All exist doors are easily operable without the use of a key, card, code or similar means. Exist doors are regularly checked to ensure they function satisfactorily. Records of these checks are kept and can be produced on request. Notices detailing the actions to be taken in the event of fire or other emergency are prominently displayed and maintained in good condition. All fire existing and means of escape are signed in accordance with BS5499

The prevention of public nuisance

All food waste is bagged and tied. Waste collection receptacles (skips/bins) are kept locked. Collections of refuse are made at appropriate intervals.

The protection of children from harm

The applicant is a signatory to the Portman Group Code of Practice on Naming, Packaging and Promotion of alcoholic drink. Staff are trained to request evidence of age form any person seeking to buy alcohol and appearing to the member of staff to be under the age of 21. Such evidence is to be of a photographic nature such as a passport or photographic driving licence or any identification card carrying the "Pass" logo. The applicant actively supports a Proof of Age Scheme. Age prompts on the tills alert a cashier when age restricted products are scanned. Signage advising staff and customers of agents for restricted products are displayed prominently in the store.



Good Morning,

I have discussed the application for 24 hour sale of alcohol at the premises with the local Inspector, Sergeants and Officers, and there are concerns which have been raised. The proposals are likely to lead to increased crime and disorder, public nuisance and anti social behaviour and there does not appear to have been any consideration of the impact to Ringwood Town Centre.

Although your clients may see the main trade as passing trade from the A31, there is no other 24 hour premises in the Ringwood area. The access to the premises from Ringwood town is West Street which has no footpath and is a narrow unlit road. All premises within Ringwood close at 00:00, and there is already difficulty clearing the town after closing due to lack of public transport/taxis. Having the opportunity to purchase alcohol 24/7 would see a significant number buying alcohol and hanging around the market pace well into the early hours, increasing Crime and Disorder.

As I am aware the previous premises licence allowed the shop to operated 24 hours with late night refreshment between 23:00 - 05:00 and the sale of alcohol between 08:00 - 23:00.

Please can you discuss with your clients reducing the Sale of alcohol between 08:00 - 23:00 on the new premises licence.

I would like to comment on the application for a night time food outlet together with 24 hour sale of alcohol at this location. I have no connection with the licensed trade and saw a notice of the application whilst walking past the site.

Local residents (there are around 450 homes nearby in East Dorset) already suffer problems with litter and late night vehicle activity on the minor road to Matchams/Hurn. The provision of through the night catering services is likely to increase and extend these nuisances which have to be dealt with by the local authority and police.

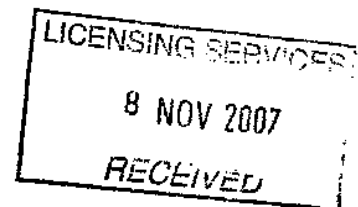
The provision of round the clock alcohol from a filling station serving car and commercial vehicle users is likely to increase health and safety risks to vulnerable users and thereby to other road users. The availability close to Ringwood may also cause additional public order issues within the town.
