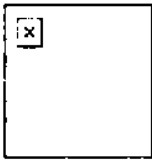

Hampshire Police object to the application for a premises licence at Ellingham & Ringwood R.F.C under the 'prevention of crime and disorder' and 'prevention of public nuisance' objectives of the licensing Act 2003, in respect of the proposed terminal hour for licensable activities and operating schedule.

The current proposal is to cease licensable activities at 02.00am on a Saturday & Sunday morning, this would make the premises the latest opening licensed premises in the immediate area and our experience elsewhere is that revellers will always migrate to the latest opening premise often having already consumed significant quantities of alcohol. This leads to difficulties for the management and control of such people and a significantly higher risk of alcohol fuelled crime and disorder. If the applicant were allowed to remain open until 02.00am the local police would have to find resources to cover at closing time and if local beat teams are required to work later into the early hours each day then it would inevitably mean they will not be available at other times when demand is often higher.

The premises is situated at Parsonage Barn Lane where there are residential properties in close proximity, it is highly probable that customers leaving the premises in the early hours of the morning will cause a disturbance to residents both in the vicinity and in adjacent streets as they make their way home.

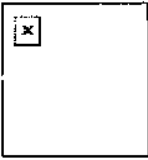

The Council would have no objection if the applicant was prepared to amend the application to comply with the conditions set out in Planning Permission 06/88549, i.e.

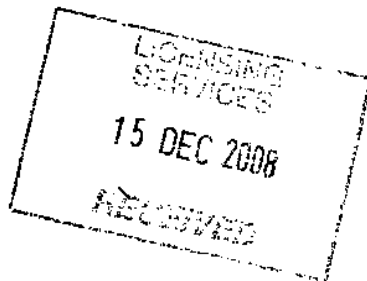
- 8) *The site shall be vacated no later than 2300hrs Monday to Saturday and 2000hrs on Sundays.*
- 11) *There shall be no provision of alcohol on the site Monday to Friday except on a maximum of 6 occasions in any calendar year.*
- 12) *The club room shall not be used for any private or public entertainment involving the use of amplified music, other than that played as recorded background music (this condition specifically excludes the provision of discos and other live entertainment involving amplified music) and at no time shall a public address system be used on the site.*

However, if the applicant is not prepared to amend the application to this effect, the Council would object on the grounds that any longer hours than those permitted under that consent could cause a public nuisance or affect the ability of public authorities to prevent crime and disorder. The application as it stands would violate two of the four licensing objectives; 1) prevention of crime and disorder and 2) prevention of public nuisance.

Please note that we object totally to these parts of the licence application.

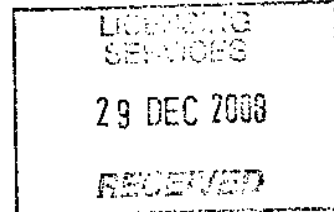

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are writing this letter to object to the licensing application for the newly developed rugby club premises on Ringwood School Playing Fields on Parsonage Barn Lane. Specifically:

- For the sale of alcohol on and off premises
- For the provision of regulated entertainment
- For the provision of late night refreshment

Hopefully this letter should not be necessary because, as stated in paragraph 9.1 of the New Forest District Council Statement of Policy (Licensing Act 2003),

“Licensing applications will not be a re-run of the planning application, and licensing decisions will not cut across decisions taken by the planning committee or permissions granted on appeal. To achieve this, close liaison will be maintained between the General Purposes and Licensing and Planning Development Control Committees”

NFDC Licensing Services must already be aware therefore that a number of restrictions were placed on the use of these premises by the PDCC in response to planning application 06/88549 which include:

8) The site shall be vacated no later than 2300hrs Monday to Saturday and 2000hrs on Sundays.

9) The site shall only be used for sport training purposes on up to three weekday evenings per week and not at all in the evenings at weekends and such use shall cease by 2130hrs.

11) There shall be no provision of alcohol on the site Monday to Friday except on a maximum of 6 occasions in any calendar year.

12) The club room shall not be used for any private or public entertainment involving the use of amplified music, other than that played as recorded background music (this condition specifically excludes the provision of discos and other live entertainment involving amplified music).

Reason: In the interests of the residential amenities of the area in accordance with policy DW-E43 on the New Forest District Local Plan First Alteration.

As my wife and I both work full time, we have not had (and will not have) the opportunity to travel across the Forest to view the licensing application in the council offices in Lyndhurst. We have however, been reliably informed by a neighbour that the application submitted to Licensing Services for the use of the premises and for provision of alcohol, entertainment and food, significantly exceeds these restrictions and therefore contravenes the planning application decision.

Parsonage Barn Lane and other roads in the vicinity of the Ringwood School Playing Fields are residential areas of hitherto low ambient noise and light levels. The development of the rugby club premises, including the installation of 80 metre high floodlights which illuminate the night sky for miles around, went ahead despite objections from local residents. This was due to a well orchestrated lobby of rugby club members, few of whom live within sight or sound of the premises.

Without the planning restrictions listed above, the development of this club will have a significant detrimental impact on the quality of life of the local residents. Furthermore, there is absolutely no need for the premises to provide alcohol as there are already three convenience stores licensed to sell alcohol within walking distance, and numerous other outlets in Ringwood town centre.

We trust therefore, that NFDC will not grant this licensing application.
