Police	<p>It has been agreed between Mr Castle, Club Secretary on behalf of the Club and the Police, the following amendments to the application:</p> <p>The current hours for the Club Premises Certificate for licensable activities will remain the same with the below be added to the Non Standard Timings for Sections B, E, F, G , I, J, L, and M as follows:</p> <p>The sale of alcohol and regulated entertainment shall be permitted up to 01:00hrs on no more than 20 occasions a year. The Club Secretary shall ensure the Licensing Authority and Police receive a written notice not less than 10 clear days prior to the event. In calculating the notice period it shall not include the day the notice is received or the day of the event. The police may only object if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the proposed event will not promote the licensing objectives.</p> <p>To be added to the Operating Schedule:</p> <p>The Club Secretary shall ensure that every individual who appears to be under 21 years of age seeking to purchase or be supplied with alcohol at or from the premises shall produce means of identification acceptable to the licensing authority proving that individual to be 18 years of age or older. ELING SAILING CLUB IS A SMALL SAILING AT THE HEAD OF ELING CREEK OCCUPYING A BUILDING ADJOINING THE ELING TIDE MILL WHICH IS LEASED FROM NEW FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL. THE CLUB LICENCE CURRENTLY ALLOWS ALCOHOL TO BE SUPPLIED BETWEEN THE HOURS 10.00 TO 23.00 MONDAY TO SATURDAY AND BETWEEN 12.00 AND 22.30 ON SUNDAY. MEMBERSHIP OF THE CLUB IS LIMITED TO 200 UNDER THE TERMS OF THE LEASE. THE CLUB OPENS ON TUESDAY AND FRIDAY EVENINGS AND ON SATURDAY LUNCHTIME. THE CLUB IS PROFESSIONALLY MANAGED BY AN EXPERIENCED COMMITTEE WHO ARE ALL AWARE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF THE LICENSING OBJECTIVES. IT HAS A SET OF RULES WHICH COVERS ALL ASPECTS OF THE OBJECTIVES WITH A STRONG EMPHASIS ON PROPER BEHAVIOUR AND THE SAFETY OF ALL. THE CLUB HAS A ROBUST MISCONDUCT PROCEDURE TO ENSURE ALL MEMBERS OBEY THE RULES OF THE CLUB.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

THE CLUB HAS GOOD LIAISON WITH LOCAL POLICE. THE FORMER COMMODORE IS A SERVING POLICE OFFICER AND THE CURRENT SECRETARY IS A RETIRED SENIOR DETECTIVE OFFICER. CLUB RULES ARE CIRCULATED TO ALL MEMBERS INDICATING STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOUR EXPECTED. THE CLUB IS IN THE PROCESS OF INSTALLING CCTV SYSTEM AND AN ELECTRONIC CARD ENTRY SYSTEM. THE BAR AREA IS ALARMED AS IS THE OUTER DOOR TO THIS AREA. ALL FUNCTIONS IN THE CLUB ARE APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE BEFOREHAND.

c) Public safety

THE CLUB HAS A MEMBER WHO ACTS AS THE SAFETY OFFICER AND HAS HIS OWN HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY. HE HAS RECENTLY COMPILED A FULL RISK ASSESSMENT FOR THE CLUB NOT ONLY FOR MEMBERS BUT ALSO ANY GUESTS ATTENDING. THE RISK ASSESSMENT HAS IDENTIFIED STEPS THAT NEED TO BE TAKEN TO IMPROVE SAFETY EVEN MORE.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

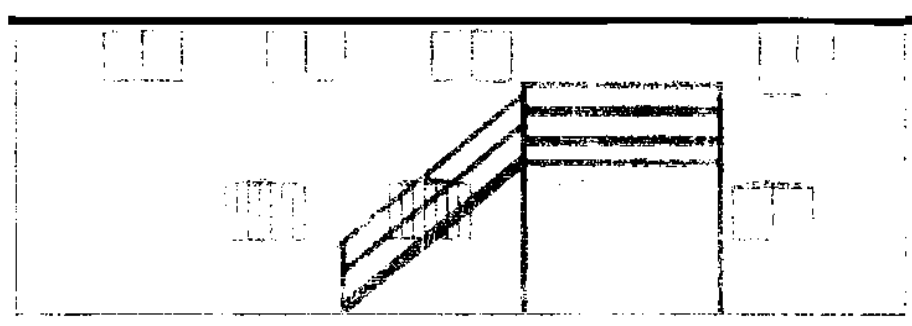
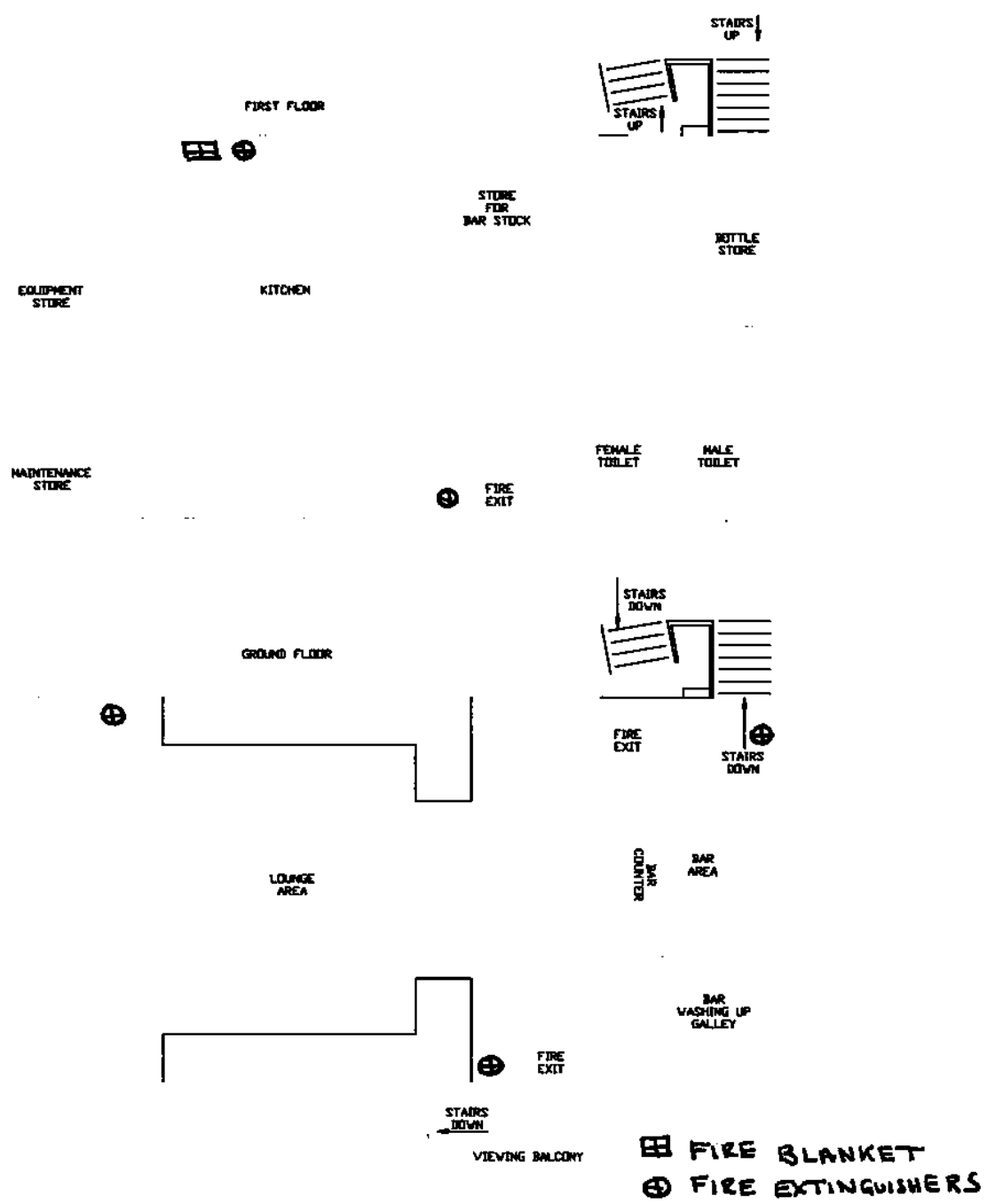

Regarding the application by Mr Philip John Castle to vary the club premises license for Eling Sailing Club, Tide Mill, Totton, SO40 9HF to extend the licensing hours at the premises.

I strongly oppose this application on the following grounds:

The Sailing club 'members' have no respect for the fact that they are situated in the middle of a residential area. Until this notice appeared I was under the impression that they already had in place such a licence. That is obviously not the case so this can only mean that they have had absolutely no regard for the terms of whatever license they currently hold.

Throughout the summer season it is usual for them to have 'lock ins', especially following one of their little regattas, as was demonstrated last night (Saturday 9th May 2009) with their barbeque and partying going on well into the morning. I can guarantee that throughout their 'season' they will have a dozen of these events, all ending with those not sleeping over loudly returning to their vehicles or staggering home, shouting and swearing, if they live locally. As they did last night, well about half past one this morning actually.

Being a resident in this area the antics of this club, including their 'board / committee', are nothing short of criminal, I have either been ignored when I have complained to them via written, hand delivered, correspondence or verbally abused and told to 'get off' their premises

when attempting to complain verbally, they are nothing but a law unto themselves. And I am not an elderly person who is easily intimidated.

I have witnessed them staggering from their club, rubbing the 'sleep' from their eyes, first thing on numerous mornings over the past 3 years, as I did between 07.30 – 08.15 hours this morning, and I don't doubt the 4 members concerned were only the 'early risers'. They were not going to sail anywhere because the tide was fully out, so any suggestion that they had just arrived is derisory.

They also insist on abandoning their vehicles, taking all the available parking, being abusive when asked if they wouldn't mind parking so that at least one other vehicle could park, or so that the householder can use the entrance to his premises. They leave their vehicles in situ while they sail off for the weekend, even though there is a free car park not 2 minutes walk from their premises.
