43-45 Parsonage Barn Lane – Application by the Co-operative Ltd for Licensed Premises: Monday to Sunday 0600 to 2300

I am writing as an interested party to object to the above application for licensed premises. This application, if granted, would pave the way for a significant increase in licensed trading hours at these premises and breach the licensing objectives by increasing public nuisance.

For "public nuisance" I refer to the chronic erosion of the quality of life and the ongoing low-level nuisance suffered by the families living in the vicinity of these premises on Parsonage Barn Lane. Such nuisance includes but is not limited to:

- 1. Noise from deliveries. The current opening hours are 0700 to 2200, six days a week and 0800 to 2200 on Sunday. Delivery lorries regularly arrive before the premises are open to customers, sometimes as early as 0630. Such lorries make considerable noise, including the noise from diesel engines, metal tail gates being lowered (dropped!) onto the pavement, electric ramps being operated and metal food cages and trolleys being wheeled between van and shop. Should the application for licensed hours from 0600 to 2300 be granted, it will only be a matter of time before the shop owners decide to start opening earlier. The inevitable consequence is that deliveries will also start earlier. How are the local residents supposed to sleep, undisturbed, until a reasonable hour in the morning?
- 2. Noise from customers and staff. At present the shop closes at 2200. Nevertheless, noise (and light) continues to eminate from the premises for some time afterwards. It is often not until 2215 or later that the lights are turned off, the last of the staff have driven away and the last of the customers have dissipated from the front of the shop. If the shop were licensed and therefore open until 2300, the actual time at which activity at the premises ceases would be closer to 2315. This would leave less than 7 hours of undisturbed rest before morning deliveries commence again.
- 3. The congregation of undesirables in a residential area. Particularly at weekends the shop attracts teenagers and young adults on their way to and from Ringwood town centre. Often there people congregate and loitre outside the premises before and after making their purchases. It is not unknown for the local police to be

called to the premises following a disturbance. If the licensing hours are extended to 2300, this shop will become well known as *the only* place in Ringwood where alcohol may be purchased at that time of night. Even Threshers – the off license in the town centre, closes at 2200. Inevitably it will attract more people on their way home from a night out in the town centre, many of them inebriated, and continue to do so longer into the night. Such people are highly likely to be rowdy, possibly aggressive, slower to disperse and prone to low level crime and disorder.

I appreciate that planning considerations are generally inadmissable when it comes to licensing decisions, but these premises have been subject to three planning applications in recent years, indeed one is ongoing at the moment. In all cases there has been an increase in opening hours, noise, light and air pollution generated by the premises, litter dropped by customers, and increased traffic noise and congestion caused by deliveries. This "drip, drip" erosion in local amenity is because each individual planning and licensing application, judged in isolation, seems reasonable. However, the cumulative effect of a number of such decisions has seen the premises develop from a family home in a residential area, to a local convenience store, to a national chain supermarket.

Therefore, in the interest of local amenity and to prevent further public nuisance to the residents who live within sight and sound of the premises, I urge the licensing committee to reject this application and insist on more reasonable licensing hours.

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
