We are a national retailer that sells alcohol as part of a broad offering of goods and services. We have held off-licences in our stores for many years and are an approved British Institute of Inn-keeping examination centre. We have written training policies and formal training programmes are in place, which ensure our people are equipped to meet all licensing objectives. All training and revision/refresher materials are reviewed regularly and reflect the requirements of the Act. All stores currently comply with our Think 25 policy, this policy is brought to customer's attention through point of sale material within the store. We take legal compliance very seriously and in addition to local training we employ a central alcohol licensing compliance manager and have a compliance committee. All the measures that we currently have in place during licensed hours would continue to be in place during any additional hours that alcohol would be sold in the store.
