Subject: Pavilion Woodside Park, Lymington/ LSA Trading Ltd

I am writing to object to the application for the commercial bar license application re the above, on the following grounds:

- 1. the license should be for sports related activities only and not a full commercial trading license
- 2. it is a direct contradiction of the undertaking by LSA in support of the planning application
- 3. the pavilion is listed as a night club on 192.com
- 4. 24/7 trading from 11.00 to 22.00 is unacceptable for a sports activity premises
- 5. such an establishment in the area is unsuited to local roads and for delivery vehicles
- 6. the latter will be a hazard for walkers and pedestrians, other vehicles and children
- 7. it raises the risk of further anti-social behaviour in the Park and risks to children
- 8. it will raise noise levels and cause disturbances to local residents
- 9. long licensing hours are likely to increase criminal/ drunken behaviour and put further strain on police resources
- 10. Woodside Park was never intended for such use by the gift of Colonel Rooke

I trust this application will be refused.
