## ELECTIONS 4 MAY 2023 - REPORT OF THE RETURNING OFFICER

## 1. RECOMMENDATION

1.1 That the Returning Officer's report, be noted.

## 2. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

2.1 The quadrennial elections for members of the District Council and Parish and Town Councils in the New Forest District took place on Thursday 4 May 2023.
2.2 Following the conclusion of the Electoral Review of the District Council, carried out by the Local Government Boundary Commission, the number of New Forest District Councillors reduced from 60 to 48 for these elections.
2.3 Notices of election for the 48 seats on the District Council and the 350 seats on the Parish/Town Councils were published on Monday 20 March 2023. The number of candidates validly nominated were:

- District Council - 160
- Parish/Town Councils - 367
2.4 At the elections in May 2019, there were 130 candidates for District Council seats and 361 for Parish/Town Councils.
2.5 This set of elections has been particularly complex and in line with good practice we will undertake a review to identify where improvements can be made for future elections. The conclusions of this review will be brought forward as an item to General Purposes \& Licensing Committee in due course.


## 3. POLLS

3.1 All 26 District Wards were contested.
3.2 Elections were held in the following Parish/Town Councils

- Fawley Parish Council (Blackfield \& Langley and Holbury Ward)
- Fordingbridge Town Council
- Hythe \& Dibden Parish Council (Butts Ash Ward, Dibden Purlieu Ward, Dibden Ward, Hythe East Ward, Hythe West Ward and Langdown Ward)
- Lymington \& Pennington Town Council (Buckland Ward, Lymington Ward and Pennington Ward)
- New Milton Town Council (Ashley North Ward, Ashley South Ward, Ballard Ward, Barton \& Becton Ward, Bashley Ward and Milton Ward)
- Ringwood Town Council (Ringwood North Ward and Ringwood South Ward)
- Totton \& Eling Town Council (Totton Central Ward, Totton East Ward, Totton North Ward, Totton South East Ward, Totton South Ward, Totton South West Ward and Totton West Ward)
- Woodgreen Parish Council


### 3.3 38 Parish/Town Councils or Parish/Town Council wards were uncontested, and 199 candidates were elected unopposed.

3.4 Polling took place at 98 polling stations. The verification and the counting of votes were held at Applemore Health \& Leisure following the close of poll.
3.5 Postal ballot papers were issued to 22,450 electors, and 16,002 items of post were returned. 15,732 district postal papers were included in the count. 10,196 parish postal papers were also included in the count. $0.3 \%$ of the postal votes returned were rejected on opening because the signatures or dates of birth were missing or did not match those recorded at application. A further $1.1 \%$ were rejected due to there being no postal voting statement. These were not included in the count.
3.6 A total of 45,511 District ballot papers were included in the count. 353 ballot papers ( $0.8 \%$ ) were spoilt and were rejected. This is lower than the $2.8 \%$ rejected in 2019.
3.7 A total of 28,985 Parish ballot papers were included in the count. 328 ballot papers ( $1.1 \%$ ) were spoilt and were rejected. This is higher than the $0.9 \%$ rejected in 2019.

## 4. DISTRICT COUNCIL ELECTION RESULTS

4.1 The results are shown in Appendix 1.
4.2 The overall percentage poll for the District Council elections was $32.4 \%$ which matched the turn out recorded at the last quadrennial elections in May 2019.

## 5. PARISH COUNCIL POLLS AND ELECTION RESULTS

5.1 All Parish/Town Council election results are on the District Council's website at www.newforest.gov.uk/article/3298/Town-and-parish-election-results
5.2 The overall percentage poll for the Parish/Town Council elections was $30.6 \%$
5.3 Where insufficient nominations were received to fill all the vacant seats, the Parish or Town Council may within 35 days of the election, co-opt members to fill the vacancies. Any person co-opted must meet the usual qualification rules for membership of a Parish or Town Council.
5.4 Insufficient nominations were received for Rockbourne Parish Council and therefore a new notice of election was published on the District Council's website on Tuesday 9 May 2023.

## 6. VOTER ID

6.1 These elections were the first subject to the new Elections Act 2022 regulations which required electors to produce an accepted form of photographic ID before they may be issued with a ballot paper.
6.256 voters applied for and were not initially issued with a ballot paper. Of those 57.1\% later returned with an accepted form of ID and were issued with a ballot paper.
6.324 electors applied for but were not issued with a ballot paper by close of poll, representing $0.1 \%$ of eligible electors.

## ALLOCATION OF SEATS AND APPOINTMENTS TO COMMITTEES AND PANELS

## 1. RECOMMENDATIONS

1.1 That the allocation of seats to committees and panels in accordance with the principles set out in the report, be agreed as at the table at paragraph 4.4 of the report; and
1.2 That the Council appoints councillors to individual committees and panels, as identified in Appendix 1, for the four year period ending May 2027.

## 2. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

2.1 In accordance with Section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, it is necessary to review the representation of political groups on committees, when the authority holds its Annual Meeting. For this purpose, "committees" includes the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Panels but excludes the Cabinet.
2.2 There are four statutory principles of political balance which have to be applied in filling appointments to committees. These are contained in Section 15(5) of the Act.
2.3 The principles that have to be applied are as follows:-
(a) that not all seats on the body are allocated to the same political group;
(b) that the majority of the seats on the body are allocated to a particular political group if the number of persons belonging to that group are a majority of the Authority's membership;
(c) subject to paragraphs (a) and (b) above, that the number of seats on the ordinary committees of a relevant Authority which are allocated to each political group bears the same proportion to the total of all the seats on the ordinary committees of that Authority as is borne by the number of members of that group to the membership of the Authority; and
(d) subject to paragraphs (a) to (c) above, that the number of seats on the body which are allocated to each political group bears the same proportion to the same number of all seats on that body as is borne by the number of members of that group to the membership of the Authority.
2.4 Once the Council has determined the allocation of committee places between the political groups, the Council must then appoint the nominees of the political groups to the committees.
2.5 Those members who are not members of political groups have no legal entitlement to an allocation of seats on committees. However, once the political groups' entitlement has been reached, the remaining seats may be filled by members not belonging to a political group. Such Members are classed as being non-aligned.
2.6 These provisions need not be applied if a different position is agreed without any member of the authority voting against.
2.7 It should be noted that, although the legislative position refers to "political" groups, this also includes the Independent Group. Although not affiliated with a political party, the Independent Group have formed a group in accordance with the legislation.

## 3. CURRENT POSITION

3.1 Following the quadrennial District Council elections on 4 May 2023, the political balance of the Council stands at:-

Conservative Group 26 (54.17\%)
Liberal Democrat Group 14 (29.17\%)
Independent Group 4 (8.33\%)
Green Group 3 (6.25\%)
Labour 1 (Non-aligned)
4. APPOINTMENTS TO COMMITTEES AND PANELS
4.1 Subject to the Council's resolution at its Annual Meeting, there will be 84 seats to which appointments should be made under the principles of proportionality.
4.2 The application of the percentages outlined at paragraph 3.1 provides for the following allocation of seats to political groups across the overall Council position:-

Conservative Group 46
Liberal Democrat Group 25
Independent Group 7
Green Group 5
Unallocated 1
4.3 Having regard to the overall position outlined at paragraph 4.2, the application of the percentages outlined at paragraph 3.1 requires the rounding up or down of calculated figures to give whole numbers on individual committees. The Council should, as far as practicable, ensure fairness on each committee and across the wider allocation in making these adjustments.
4.4 Therefore, having received notifications of preferences from the political groups in accordance with the proportionality principles, a recommended allocation of seats is outlined below, which will meet the proportionality requirements, aggregating all committee places and allocating fair shares:-

4.5 The Council could also resolve to allocate a seat(s) to the non-aligned Members. The Council's Constitution makes provision for the allocation of seats to Members who are not members of a political group, as nearly as possible in proportion to the number of those members on the Council. There is one remaining seat that could be allocated to the non-aligned Member, outside of those that should be allocated to the political groups. As above, the non-aligned Member has been allocated a place on the Appeals Committee.
4.6 The nominees of the political groups to the committees and panels are attached at Appendix 1. The calculations are based on the committees as they stand as per the recommended Council resolution of 22 May 2023. It should be noted that if Members seek to make any amendments, this may affect the calculations.
