**2020-21 FEES AND CHARGES – ENVIRONMENT AND REGULATORY
SERVICES PORTFOLIO**

1. ITEM FOR DECISION

As part of the annual review of budgets, decisions are required to agree any non-statutory fees and charges for the forthcoming financial year.

2. POLICY FRAMEWORK

The decisions over fees and charges have to be within the constraints of the overall financial framework and the medium term financial plan. At the same time, decision making regarding the fees and charges must reflect a 'commercial' environment where there is a need to react swiftly and proactively to changing conditions. As a result power to agree fees and charges, or to make formal arrangements for the setting of fees and charges within a Portfolio, is delegated to the Portfolio Holder.

3. CONSULTATION UNDERTAKEN

The relevant Service Manager has implemented consultation procedures as appropriate for the various fees and charges applicable and the Portfolio Holder has been involved in the process or been notified of the outcome. The proposed fees and charges for 2020-21 are attached as Appendix 1.

The Portfolio Holder's decision has due regard to any issues which have emerged from the consultation.

4. OPERATIONAL IMPLICATIONS

Garden waste charges have increased marginally due to the ongoing increased costs arising from problems in employing HGV Drivers and the increase in fuel costs.

Due to the demand for re-inspections under the National Food Hygiene Rating Scheme, the charge of £162 per re - inspection has been increased to £185 to cover the actual costs incurred. This is a discretionary service where the Local Authority can recover costs and it helps in driving up food hygiene and safety standards in food businesses across the district.

The fee of £88.00 (based on 2 hours officer time) for export certificates for the business and inspection of the premises/food product will remain unchanged but the £33 per certificate issued will be increased to £40 to cover costs incurred.

The beach hut site rentals have been increased by around 3.6% and these have been agreed with representatives from the Beach Hut Owners Association. Also, following various requests to consider the charge for transferring the ownership of a beach hut, this has now been reviewed for the second year running, which has seen reductions of 6.8% on the 2019/20 fee.

Cemetery fees have been compared against other local authorities and amended accordingly to ensure that the fees that we set continue to be at the lower end of what other authorities are charging for the same service.

Fees for Special Collections Refuse Collections (Bulky Items) have increased by 20%, to encourage more residents to reuse their old furniture through the charitable organisations who provide this service.

The fees for inspecting and licencing horse livery establishments has increased between 15 and 20% due to the time taken to inspect these facilities and the need to fully recover costs.

5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Any financial implications will have been or will be reported as part of the ongoing Portfolio Plan and budgetary control.

The commercial waste charges will be agreed with the Portfolio Holder on a regular basis during the year to meet the needs of the service to make them competitive in the changing market.

6. ENVIRONMENTAL, CRIME & DISORDER AND EQUALITY & DIVERSITY IMPLICATIONS

There are no implications arising directly as a result of this decision. Any impacts as a result of altered service delivery outcomes would have been reflected as part of the Portfolio Plan and budget setting processes.

7. RECOMMENDATION

- 7.1 That the fees and charges attached as Appendix 1 be agreed and implemented from 1 April 2020.
