ENVIRONMENT AND REGULATORY SERVICES PORTFOLIO HOLDER DECISION: 14 OCTOBER 2020

2021 FEES & CHARGES – KEYHAVEN RIVER

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 As part of the annual review of budgets, decisions are required to agree any nonstatutory fees and charges for the forthcoming financial year.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 The decisions over fees and charges have to be within the constraints of the overall financial framework and the medium-term financial plan. At the same time, decision making regarding the fees and charges must reflect a 'commercial' environment where there is a need to react swiftly and proactively to changing conditions. As a result, power to agree fees and charges, or to make formal arrangements for the setting of fees and charges within a Portfolio, is delegated to the Portfolio Holder.

3. ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 The 12-month charging period for fees and charges for the Keyhaven river was altered so that the calendar year as opposed to the financial year is the new charging period. A pro rata rate was applied to annual mooring fees for 2020 in recognition of this change. 2021 will therefore be the first full calendar year charging period. The change was made to improve efficiency in the use of the facilities and to ensure those keen to obtain a mooring can be accommodated on vacant moorings. This will allow them to get full use during the spring and summer season.
- 3.2 There is a need to upgrade the moorings on the Keyhaven river with a new heavier ground chain system. It is anticipated that once completed this will improve confidence in our mooring system with mooring holders as well as increasing occupancy and significantly shortening of waiting times for moorings. Improving occupancy levels will help cover the cost of the work and therefore any fee increases for 2021 will be fair and proportionate to all.
- 3.3 In addition to assist with payments during the current economic climate, those who set up and pay by direct debit will be entitled to a 10% discount on annual fees and will have the opportunity to spread the payments over the first 4 months January to April. We are also aware of the difficult season that the Commercial fisherman have had and the fees for their moorings have been reduced to reflect this.
- 3.4 To bring Keyhaven river in line with other harbour and river authorities operating in the area, it is proposed that the term 'River dues' is used as a term that correctly qualifies the charges we make for vessels 'entering, using or leaving the river or using the Keyhaven river landing facilities'. This includes vessels of any size being launched or recovered from the river, anchoring and short-term mooring of vessels in the river. The revenue derived from river dues mooring fees is used by NFDC to meet the full cost of the management of the Keyhaven river. This covers giving advice and assistance, maintenance of navigational aids and the enforcement of byelaws. Annual, temporary, and private licenced mooring fee payers have this incorporated into their fees and therefore will not have to pay 'river dues' each time they leave, enter or use the river.

4. **PROPOSED CHANGE**

- 4.1 The 2021 Fees and charges for the Keyhaven River are amended to the amounts detailed at Appendix 1.
- 4.2 That the term 'River dues' is adopted as a term that correctly qualifies the charges we make for vessels 'entering, using or leaving the river or using the Keyhaven river landing facilities. This includes vessels of any size being launched or recovered from the river, anchoring and short-term mooring of vessels in the river.

5. OPERATIONAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 Due to the continued demand for moorings at Keyhaven the mooring and launching fees have been reviewed and, where appropriate, increased to what is considered a comparable price to other facilities in the area.

6. **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

6.1 Any financial implications will have been or will be reported as part of the ongoing Portfolio Plan and budgetary control.
