1. Near Village Hall, Damerham, SP6 3HE

PARISH: Damerham Parish Council



**Usage (last 12 months):** 0

**Accident Provision:** One slight incident (Crashmap.com)

**Demographic:** No council owned properties in close proximity (Forestmap)

**Mobile Phone Coverage:** Good (Ofcom)

**PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSE:** No comment

Recommendation: **NO OBJECTION**

**Reason:** Although it is noted that the phone may not have been working for the past year, it is felt, on balance, that the removal of the phone would not be significantly disadvantageous to the local community, having regard to mobile phone coverage within the area and local demographics.

2. Roundhill, Fordingbridge

PARISH: Fordingbridge Town Council

**Accident Provision:** One slight incident close by (Crashmap.com).

**Demographic:** No council owned properties in proximity (Forestmap)

**Mobile Phone Coverage:** Good (Ofcom)

**PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSE:** Fordingbridge Town Council - no objection and would prefer to see the box removed as well as the phone.

Recommendation: **NO OBJECTION**

3. Junction of Butlers Lane and Gorley Road, Ringwood BH24 1TJ

PARISH: Ringwood Town Council



**Usage (last 12 months):** 72

**Accident Provision:** One slight incident close by (Crashmap.com).

**Demographic:** A few Council-owned properties nearby (Forestmap)

**Mobile Phone Coverage:** Good (Ofcom)

**PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSE:** Ringwood Town Council – Object on the basis of the demographics of the area, it is in well positioned and visible area close to local shops and serves areas of social housing.

Further to this comment, originally made in February 2020, the Town Council would like to add that whilst the nation is still in the grips of the pandemic, it is more important than ever that people have access to a telephone (both for health and social reasons).

Recommendation: **OBJECTION**

**Reason:** The level of use of this public payphone indicates that it is of some value to the community. The consultation with Ringwood Town Council has revealed that they are of the view that this payphone should be retained due to the demographics of the area which is

close to areas of social housing. The payphone is well positioned in a visible location close to local shops. Although the number of its calls is relatively modest, the importance of the calls needs to be given significant weighting. The Council has considered the changing technological environment and commercial conditions that have generated the application for the removal of the PCB. On balance, the Council consider that the removal of the PCB would, in this instance, be disadvantageous to members of the local community. On this basis, its retention is recommended.

7. Outside Post Office, North Road, Dibden Purlieu SO45 4PG

**Accident Provision:** Three slight incidents reported (Crashmap.com)

**Demographic:** A few council-owned properties nearby (Forestmap)

**Mobile Phone Coverage:** Good (Ofcom)

**PARISH COUNCIL RESPONSE:** Hythe and Dibden Parish Council – Object - The number of calls suggest there is a need, in addition, mobile phone coverage is sometimes patchy in this location. The phone box is on a school route from Noadswood Secondary School and it is felt that a public phone box should be available for use by students in an emergency.

This view is as per the PC view from earlier this year.

Recommendation: **NO OBJECTION**

**Reasons:** The level of usage appears to have dropped off significantly since the last consultation and each of the main network providers are able to provide a good service in this location.

On balance, the Council consider that the removal of the PCB would, in this instance, be disadvantageous to members of the local community. On this basis, its retention is recommended.
