In the few years that we have lived here there has been numerous incidents of violence, drunkenness, antisocial behaviour, litter and broken glass, some of which is thrown into our driveway and garden.

In the last incident on 20/4/21 the police were called after a disturbance and a drunk driver drove his car into our fence.

We can appreciate the type of business it is and that at times especially when they have live music on, that it can get quite noisy. So, to extend the closing hours till 1am would cause more stress.

Good morning,

We oppose the application to extend the opening/licensing hours at The Glen public house on New Year's Eve 2021 for the reasons set out below.

It is inevitable that increased traffic and parking will be an issue with many vehicles parking along Butts Ash Lane and in Hayley Close with some vehicles parked on pavements restricting pedestrian access. Parking along Butts Ash Lane and in Hayley Close often appears to be the preferred place to park despite The Glen having its own parking facilities. This will result in increased traffic noise through out the very early hours of 1st January along with the loud voices, singing, arguments and aggression that we all know are associated with long hours of alcohol consumption particularly on News Years Eve.

We are also concerned about anti social behaviour such as alcohol related litter, bottles and cans etc. being thrown into the road, hedgerows and gardens.

Consideration should be given to Badger's Holt Residential Care Home which is opposite The Glen. Elderly and frail residents are likely to be disturbed and worried by the noise and increased activity and access for emergency services could be impeded.

We understand that many people will want to socialise and celebrate the New year with friends and family but we feel that the extended hours to 3am on 1st January are unreasonable and unnecessary particularly in this residential area. An extension until 1am would be reasonable.

We also oppose the application for extended licensing hours from 08.00 to 01.00 hours on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesday ,Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays as detailed in application S34.

The same traffic issues and noise will ensue and increased anti social behaviour again fuelled by all day alcohol consumption from 8 am until 1am the following morning 7 days a week every week. This is totally unreasonable. We notice also that there is no time limit so it would appear that these hours would become permanent. We believe this would impact significantly on the ambience of this residential area and the safety and well being of local residents and motorists.

There appears to be a discrepancy about the extended hours applied for as the green notice says 8am to 1pm but the pending license application times laid out online show 08.00 to 01.00 which on a 24hour clock is 8am to 1am the following day.

We are writing to you to object to the application to change the permitted opening/trading hours 8am – 1pm and the extension to the end of permitted hours on New Years Eve to 03.00 hrs New Years Day.

We object to the opening at 8am as the pub is situated on a school route and this seems inappropriate for the area. We are also concerned about the extra noise issue this would cause particularly at weekends.

We object to the extension to 03.00 on New Years Day as we deem this to be unnecessary and this will increase the noise issue already experienced continually, particularly at weekends.

As very close neighbours to the public house we already experience extra noise, rubbish and fights. Police have been called sometimes but as there is no longer a local presence they usually arrive after the incident has finished and people have disappeared. The noise and fighting is particularly bad at the weekends and longer opening times whether day or night would encourage people to drink more which has a knock on effect to their behaviour. To open until 03.00 on New Years Day is unnecessary. New Years Eve seems to have become a ticketed event at most venues and as such the amount of time available to spend in the venue is enough. We have personally heard fighting, people making threats, foul language and general noise late at night. This has become worse over the last 5 – 7 years.

Having seen the application of the Glen to extend its opening hours throughout the week and on new years eve / new years day we have a serious concern about the the effect this will have on the community.

The past year has seen a dramatic rise in anti social behaviour around the Glen, we have seen the police having to attend several times during opening hours and I believe last year they had to employ security assistance for a short period to help maintain control during and after hours.

Our main concern is after hours, with the current hours the shouting, hollering and fighting in the lane is usually finished by midnight whereas with the new hours this could go on to 02:00 in the morning or 04:00 on new years day, this will have a major impact on us and our neighbours.

We have no issues with the pub and understand that they want to maximise their busines
opportunity but don't feel these hours would be a benefit to the community.

However, in more recent times there have been disturbances due to drunk and disorderly behaviour where police have been required to attend. I am concerned that in extending the hours the likelihood of disorder/drugs due to a different demographic being attracted to its venue with its 1am closing is possible.
Public safety	X	Whilst I appreciate the documents do not refer to the highway outside this venue, it is apparent that after a weekend, in particular a BH wknd when cars are left overnight, crossing the road is less safe for children (which we have experienced first-hand). Vehicles go quite fast down this straight road and you cannot always see oncoming traffic around the parked vehicles. We live down the track behind the venue and although parts are lit, it concerns me that the potential for increased movement here when under the influence of alcohol due to extended opening hours does pose a risk to local residents.
Prevention of public nuisance	Х	In more recent months we have noticed an increased level of noise from this venue in the evenings, bands playing but also with more visitors outside at the rear/beer garden – people talking/ shouting. It would be nice if the Glen, (a local business supported by local residents) gave something back and regularly undertook litter picking events with residents.

Most other venues such as the bar in Hythe hire doormen/women to screen clients, and manage difficulties as they arise although I have never seen any at the Glen (possibly as there has never previously been a need with an older client group).



We have become used to hearing shouting, fighting and screeching cars racing off and that is with windows closed. It is worse in the summer months when the bands regularly play outside in the pub garden. During lockdown when customers were sitting outside again it was excessively loud and we could often hear loud voices. Currently on their website there is a band due to play every Saturday during June July and August, not to mention the screening of the Euros during June which includes internal and external screens. We regularly have bottles and glasses left on our drive as people walk past which is totally unacceptable. This is not the location for a pub to be open for 17 hours a day seven days a week serving alcohol, with regular bands and sporting activities being screened at non standard times. If this application is approved the unacceptable noise and disturbance will impact on mine and other families peaceful living in this residential area Protection of children from harm

I moved to Eindelyk at the end of 1975 and have seen the pub change from The Jester to The Gleneagle to The Glen. My driveway runs behind the pub children's playground.

We have been witness to a very big change from a pub where you would go for a quiet drink with family

to an extremely noise place, where one should not bring children.

The noise is now from lunchtime to past midnight, this being the time to hearing drunk pub goers returning home along Forest Front, and cars starting up in the car park.

The excessive noise from live music in the garden during Bank Holidays and weekends is something we are dreading !!!

Bands often play from 15.00 o 21.00. The Glen licence allows music outside until 2100, and then to continue indoors until 0.30, but we can still, inside our house, clearly hear everything that's being played.

The Glen licence gives permission to have 12 events a year, but after 2 events with singing already, 12 days with live bands booked and more dates TBC, outdoor screening on a big screen of football for a month, this is obviously not followed. Opening the pub at 08.00 in the morning to 01.00 the next day is a VERY bad idea and I object in the strongest possible way.

An outside big screen tv or any other activity or event starting from 08.00, will increase public nuisance greatly in a very wide area, as will setting up outside self-contained serving facilities onto the patio or garden. This must not be permitted.

The Glen should not have a licence for any amplified music or voice outside the premises in an residential area, this one includes a Care Home close by.
