Introduction and background

1. Following the arising of vacancies on three Outside Bodies, this report details proposed appointments to fill those vacancies.

Criteria for appointment

- 2. The Council's agreed criteria for representation on Outside Bodies states that:-
 - (a) there will be a clear benefit to the Council and/or the inhabitants of the District through formal representation on that organisation; or
 - (b) the Council has made or is continuing to make a significant financial contribution towards the establishment or operating costs of the organisation and that appointing a representative will help ensure good governance.
- 3. The criteria for making appointments also suggests that where feasible, appointments to Outside Bodies should be made by office rather than by name.
- 4. In making appointments, the Leader should also give careful consideration to selecting the most appropriate representative, taking into account the nature of the appointment and other issues such as local representation and the relevant experience and expertise of the appointee.
