Homelessness Prevention and Relief



- Prevention of Homelessness remains the key priority to keep families in their home or find alternative accommodation.
- Understanding client needs remains a driver for identifying alternative accommodation.

 When the prevention of homelessness is not successful, Relieving Homelessness means identifying alternative accommodation. This can be emergency accommodation or NFDC owned properties.

Emergency Accommodation




- Impacted due to the number of large and complex families often with support challenges.
- Finding properties in the private rented sector remains a challenge but good links with landlords.
- Key reasons for homelessness remain S.21 notices and Friends and Family evictions.

Homesearch Housing Register



- The reduction in the number of applicants in Bands 3 and 4 is mainly due to the applicant not completing the renewal of their application.
- Bands 1 and 2 remain stable with offers of social housing.

Key developments for Homelessness and Housing Options



- Homelessness Strategy in development
- Allocations Policy refresh to be reviewed
- Both to be with Panel in January
 2026, cabinet in February 2026 and then wider public consultation.
